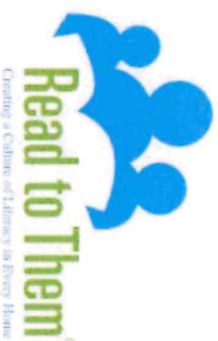
Get out of your house and read a chapter together "in the wild"!
