Parent Portal for School Buses Now Open!

The "Student Transportation" platform Parent Portal, **My Ride K-12, is now open** The My Ride K-12 app allows you and your student the ability to access estimated times for your bus' arrival, to monitor where the bus is in real time, to confirm your child when your child is boarding or disembarking from the bus, ultimately ensuring that your child is accounted for and safe as it relates to bussing. The application uses GPS technology to provide the most accurate route data with real-time updates. The application also allows for notifications to be sent to you, in the case that there are any specific changes to your bus on an emergent basis.

Linked below are step by step directions to take you through setting up the app on your computer or on a mobile phone if you are interested in doing so.

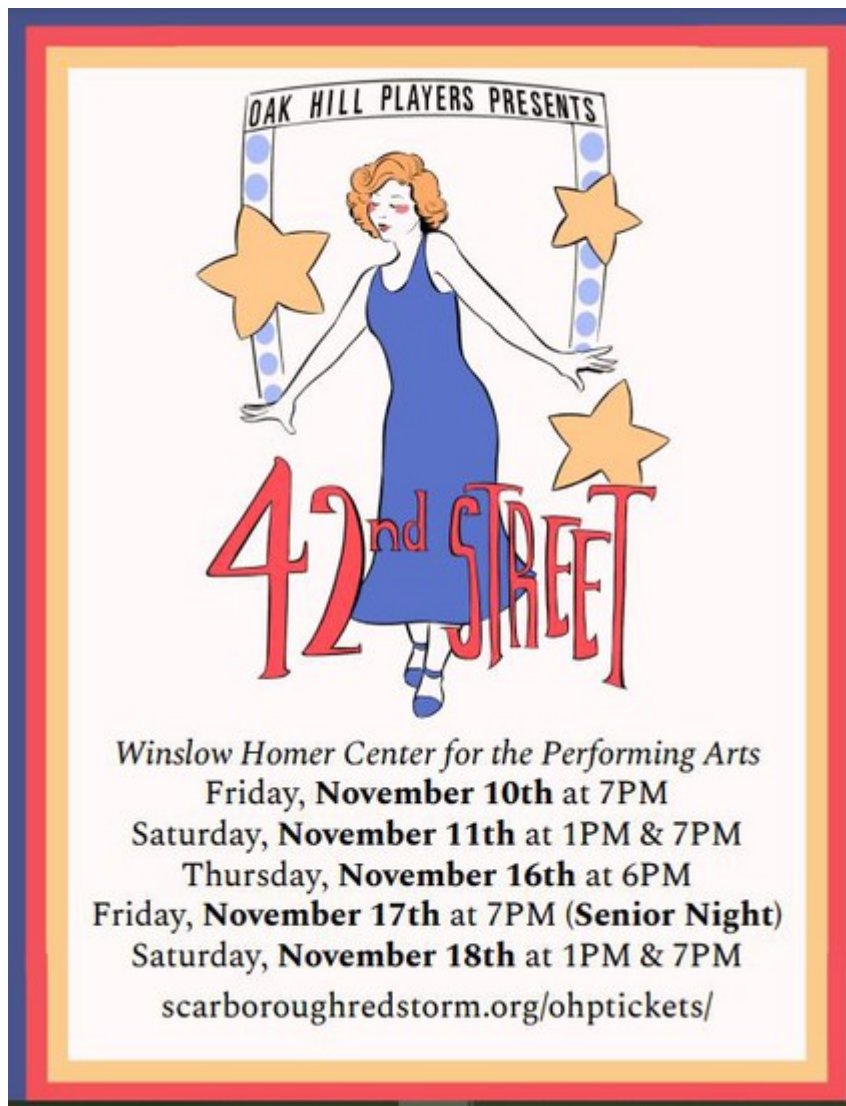

Important: Student Use of Bus Cards

My Ride K-12 gets all of its information about who is riding the bus each day from students swiping on and off with their cards. **These cards are embedded with a chip so they can be read by the swipe system. As such, replacing them comes at a cost, and it is not expected that the district will need to replace lost cards multiple times.**

Please check in with your students to establish a routine and find a safe place for their cards. The bus department will be communicating with you to let you know if your child has not been using a card so you can help to locate your child's card and to reinforce the importance of this safety feature.
