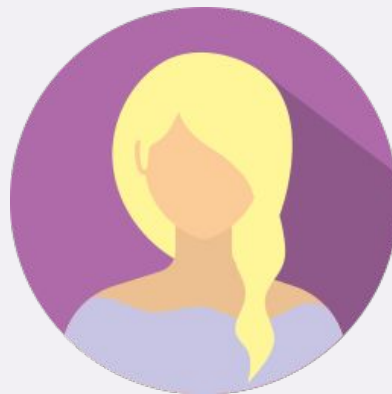

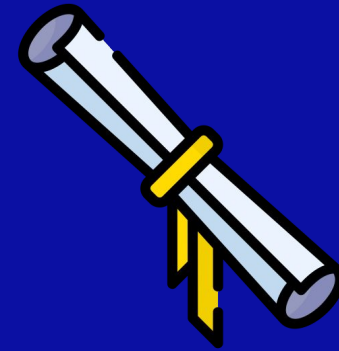

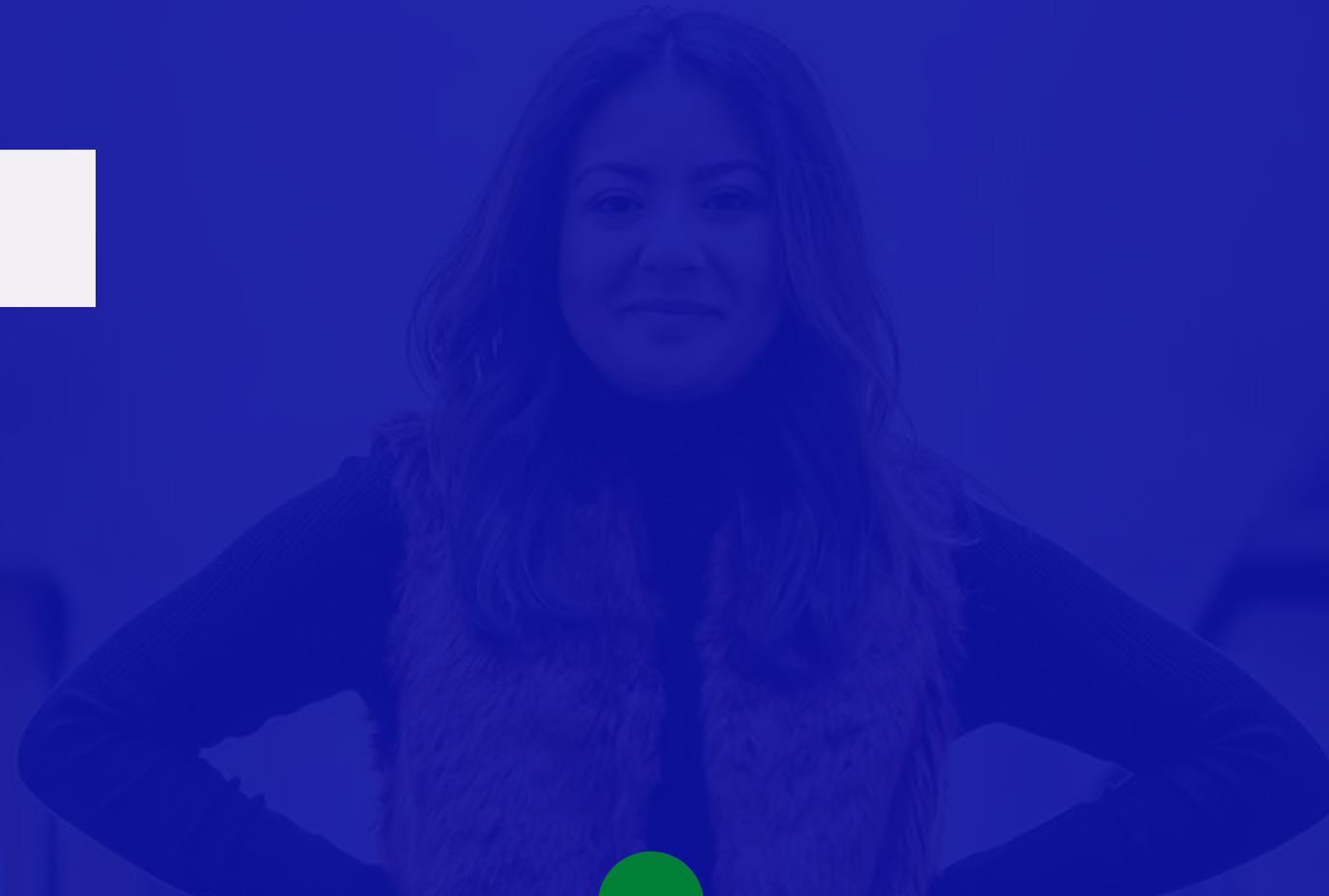

June:

- Complete June 2 information and turn in tonight
- Join Google Classroom: Join Code 52h4kv7
- Complete mandatory OCC online readiness course in MyOCC
ASAP-cannot schedule without this complete
- Call or email to make an appointment with OCC counselor and select Fall and Winter classes (will not have course numbers for winter yet but we will add them during seminar in October)

OCC Scheduling

- Counseling meeting-all students are required to meet with counselor.
- Counselor completes year long academic plan.
- Counselor completes registration and sends to ACE.
- ACE review: aligns with high school and signed.
- ACE emails forms to enrollment.
- OCC enrollment enrolls students in classes.

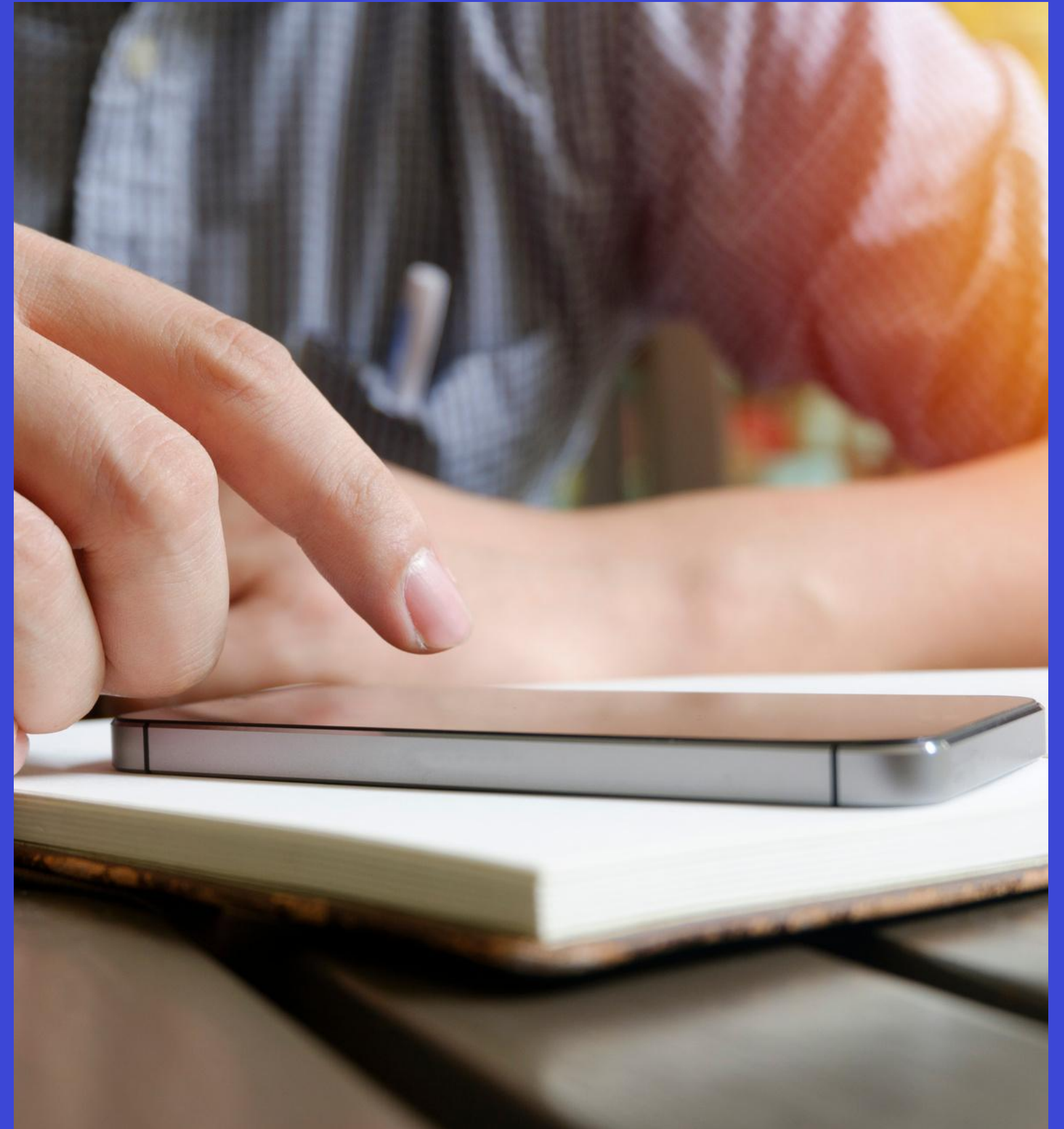

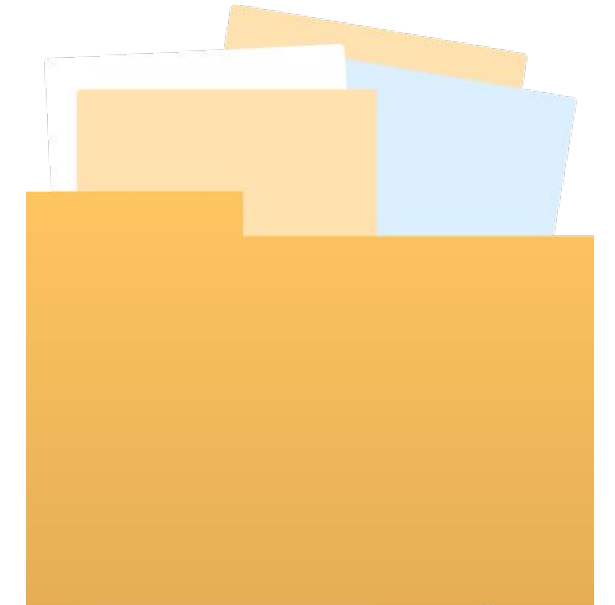
