It has been just two months since we welcomed everyone back for the 2022-2023 school year. It has been a very successful start: students are engaged in focused learning; a large percentage of students are involved in athletics, band, and extra-curricular activities; and a promising, opportunity-filled future for our county is on the horizon.

These first several weeks have included some great moments: Homecoming festivities, including alumni playing alongside our Lancer marching band; our Girls Golf Team winning the LCL and being Sectional Champion; LHS social studies teacher Brittany Baker and C-TEC teacher Mark Vukovic receiving the Excellence in Education Award sponsored by Transcendia, Inc.; and honoring our 2022 Wall of Fame Inductees.

Another sign of progress is the release of the 2022 state report card in mid-September. We achieved the highest rating – 5 stars – in both the *Progress* and *Gap Closing* metrics. We improved the proficiency percentage in 19 of the 20 achievement tests from 2021. There is room for improvement in other metrics, but I am confident that our continued dedication and intentional work is how we will continue to make progress. Whether it is systematic review of student data or how we are teaching and assessing the grade level standards, we are showing positive results for our District, but more importantly, our students.

To continue to deliver these positive student outcomes and provide valuable student opportunities, the District must sustain its financial resources. At its July meeting, the Board of Education approved a resolution to place a renewal levy on the November 8 ballot. The renewal levy results in no new taxes for taxpayers. 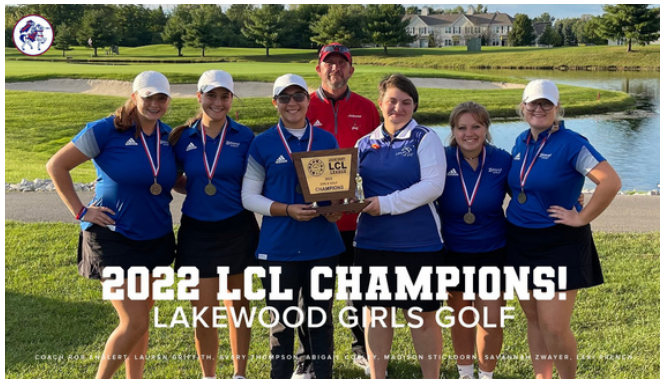
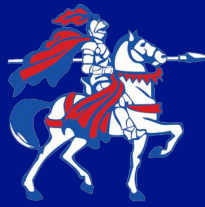

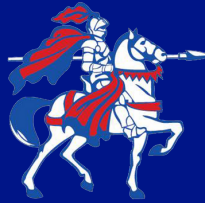


Homecoming game 2022: Griffen Jones and Sydney Kane were crowned king and queen; 200 Lancer Band members, past and present, came together for an amazing performance!





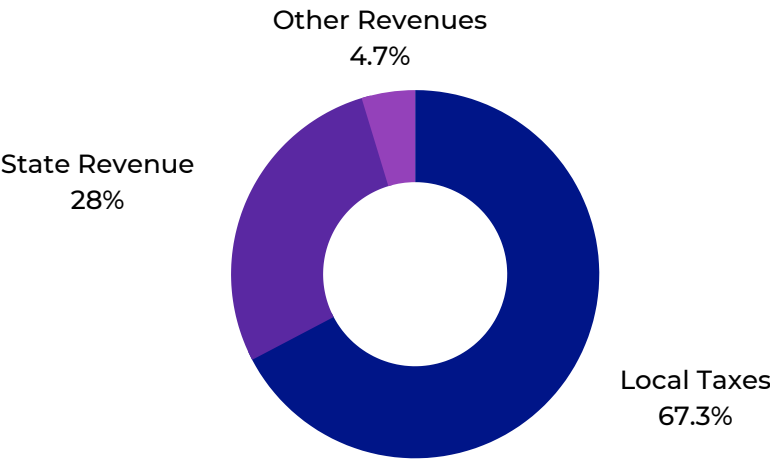
District Finances

The District paid \$199,390 in fuel costs for our buses to transport students last school year.

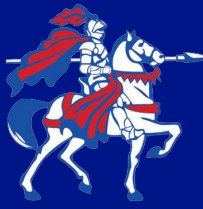
Did you know?

On July 20, 2022, the Lakewood Local School District Board of Education approved a resolution to place a renewal levy on the November 8 ballot. The renewal levy will renew two existing District emergency levies, and results in no new taxes for taxpayers.

Passing this renewal levy will not increase taxes for the Lakewood Local Schools community and would place it on a ten-year renewal cycle, meaning the next time this levy would have to be renewed is 2033.

These levies make up 24% of our annual budget and are crucial for us to continue providing great educational and extra-curricular opportunities for our students, while also helping us maintain things like salaries, utilities and maintenance. The District works very hard to spend the money provided by our taxpayers responsibly, as evidenced by revenues exceeding our expenditures in the last fiscal year.

Strategic Plan Updates

- Teaching & Learning:
 - The English/Languages Arts committee will begin a year-long review of District curriculum beginning in October.
 - 120 K-12 students participated in the summer intervention program or credit recovery in June. The district also had 183 K-4 students participate in the Kids Read Now program. These programs were entirely grant funded.
 - The high school is piloting a new math course called Mathematical Modeling and Reasoning, designed to be an equivalent to traditional Algebra II for students who do not plan to go into a career that requires Calculus.
- Facilities & Learning Environments:
 - Facilities improvement projects occurred over the summer:
 - Constructed a connecting corridor between Jackson Intermediate School (JIS) A and the Annex to allow students to move from building to building for bathrooms, lunch, specials classes, the office, and clinic safely and without being exposed to the elements.
 - Installed HVAC at Lakewood Middle School (LMS) and renovated the current LMS auditorium into four new instructional spaces, including a new band room.
- Social-Emotional Well-Being:
 - JIS has added a social worker who is available for counseling to students and staff one day a week.
- Communication & Trust:
 - Continuing to post updated information, graphics and photos on the District website to garner engagement.
 - Engaging the community through exciting content and appealing visuals on District social media channels.
