aint Paul has the earliest writings in the New Testament. His first writing is his First Letter to the Thessalonians. In this letter, Paul initiates a greeting that he continues to all of the churches to whom he writes: "We give thanks to God always for all of you, remembering you in our prayers unceasingly..."

In the United States, we dedicate one day each year to giving thanks. It is a wonderful tradition, and so important. However, Paul reminds us that we need to give thinks always. In his letters, he tells us to dedicate ourselves to gratitude, cultivate gratitude. It is a reminder that we can lose sight of that so important virtue.

OLGC, our celebration of Thanksgiving is an annual one-day event. Our Christian faith tells us that gratitude is a daily calling. Saint Paul reminds us to dedicate ourselves to gratitude to cultivate gratitude. Each day, our first prayer should be thank you Lord for this day and reminders throughout the day to thank the Lord for the day, for our family, for our friends, and for all who love us.





Gospel: Luke 17: 11-19

As Jesus continued his journey to Jerusalem, he traveled through Samaria and Galilee. As he was entering a village, ten lepers met him. They stood at a distance from him and raised their voice, saying, "Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!" And when he saw them, he said, "Go show yourselves to the priests." As they were going, they were cleansed. And one of them, realizing he had been healed, returned, glorifying God in a loud voice; and he fell at the feet of Jesus and thanked him. He was a Samaritan. Jesus said in reply. "Ten were cleansed, were they not? Where are the other nine? Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?" Then he said to him, "Stand up and go;

"Where are the other nine?"

No other story better illustrates human ingratitude than this Gospel.

your faith has saved you."

Jesus heals ten lepers at no cost to them, yet only one returns to thank him. The other nine move on with their lives.

All the Lord wanted was a word of thanks.

How often do we show our gratitude for others?

Consider the elderly.

For at least the first decade of our lives, we were totally dependent upon our parents and grandparents for food, shelter, clothing, security, and above all, for love. How do we thank them? And how might we support them as they age?

Or our veterans.

As the saying goes, "All gave some. Some gave all." How might we thank those who willingly sacrificed so much for us?

Or consider any other person in our lives—our spouse, our children, our co-workers, a teacher, a doctor, a benefactor, a friend.

Think of one person who's made a difference.

How might we thank them today?



DON'T BE AFRAID TO ASK FOR HELP

Many family caregivers are reluctant to ask for help. They know and understand their family members-their likes, dislikes, and medical and financial information. They may think to themselves, "No one can do it better than me," which can be an accurate statement. However, without help, a family caregiver may experience burnout. Burnout is a state of emotional, mental, and physical exhaustion that can lead to feelings of depression, isolation, and stress. When this happens to a caregiver, they are no longer able to provide the best care to their loved ones or to themselves.

If you find it difficult to ask for help with caregiving tasks, take a moment to reflect on the long-term impacts of caring for someone alone and the positive benefit that might come from accepting support. Consider writing out caregiving tasks and to whom you could delegate some of them. It's helpful to remember that there are lots of ways to safely and accurately complete caregiving tasks, even if they are done differently than the way you usually do them.

Asking for support is not a sign of weakness or selfishness. It's an act of selflessness to make sure you and your loved one are getting the best care possible. 
