

The smallest 2-digit number is 10. The smallest number whose digits sum to 10 is 19. The smallest number whose digits sum to 10 is 199.

Notice that each of the above minimizes the number of digits by maximizing the number of 9's, and adding the smallest digit possible at the beginning to get the needed total. Similarly, 199 can be formed with enough 9's to equal 198 (22 9's) with a 1 appended as the first digit:

ANSWER: 19.999.999.999.999.999.999.999 , or 2\*1022-1






