## SAINT OF THE WEEK



**St. Cecilia**

St. Cecilia was born in 180 AD in Rome, Italy. St. Cecilia had a deep prayer life and made a vow of virginity to God. She was promised to a young man named Valerian.

On their wedding night, St. Cecilia told her husband about the vow of virginity she had taken and that an angel was protecting her. Valerian asked to see the angel as proof, and Cecilia told him he would have eyes to see once he traveled to the third milestone on the

Via Appia (Appian Way) and was baptized by Pope Urbanus. After baptism, Valerian returned to his wife and found an angel at her side. Valerian’s brother heard the story about the angel and was inspired also to get baptized. Valerian and his brother both are captured and are martyred. St. Cecilia spent the rest of her life preaching and, through her preaching, converted over four hundred people, most of whom were baptized. She was then captured and tortured. They tried to torture her through the use of fire, but no severe marks or sweat came from her. She was then sentenced to be beheaded. St. Cecilia is regarded as the patroness of music because she heard heavenly music in her heart when she was married and is represented in art with an organ or organ-pipes in her hand.







## SANTA DE LA SEMANA




Santa Cecilia

Santa Cecilia nació en 180 d.C. en Roma, Italia. Santa Cecilia tenía una profunda vida de oración e hizo voto de virginidad a Dios. Estaba prometida a un joven llamado Valeriano. La noche de bodas, Santa Cecilia le contó a su marido el voto de virginidad que había hecho y que un ángel la protegía. Valeriano pidió ver al ángel como prueba, y Cecilia le dijo que tendría ojos para ver una vez que viajara al tercer hito de la Vía Appia (Vía Apia) y fuera bautizado por el Papa Urbano. Tras el bautismo, Valeriano regresó junto a su esposa y encontró un ángel a su lado. El hermano de Valeriano oyó la historia del ángel y se animó a bautizarse también. Valeriano y su hermano fueron capturados y martirizados. Santa Cecilia pasó el resto de su vida predicando y, gracias a su predicación, convirtió a más de cuatrocientas personas, la mayoría de las cuales fueron bautizadas. Fue capturada y torturada.

Intentaron torturarla con fuego, pero no le quedaron marcas ni sudor. Fue condenada a morir decapitada. Santa Cecilia es considerada la patrona de la música porque escuchó música celestial en su corazón cuando se casó y se la representa en el arte con un órgano o una flauta de órgano en la mano.

Mecenazgo: músicos y música.


