MAP (Measures of Academic Progress) Growth is a program of Northwest Evaluation Association, a research-based, not-for-profit organization that supports students and educators worldwide by creating assessment solutions that precisely measure growth and proficiency—and provide insights to help tailor instruction. MAP measures achievement and growth in K–12 Math, Reading, and Science. It measures what students know and provides teachers with accurate, and actionable evidence to help target instruction for each student or groups of students regardless of how far above or below they are from their grade level. Students in Kindergarten through Grade 8 are administered the MAP assessment three times a year, Fall, Winter, and Spring.
