The Town of Vernon, Connecticut will receive sealed bids from licensed firearm manufacturers, wholesalers or retailers that shall provide new, current production Glock (Gen5), Model G47 MOS 7, 9x19MM, 4.49IN, BLK, Glock suppressor height blacked-out sights, Aimpoint ACRO P2 (Direct mount), (3) 17RD Standard magazines, rail; and Glock (Gen5), Model G19 MOS, 9x19MM, 4.02IN, BLK, Glock suppressor height night sights, (3) 15RD Standard magazines, rail.

Emailed, faxed or late bids will not be accepted.

Received bids will be opened publicly in person on **Thursday, December 21, 2023 at 10:00 am**. Bid results will be posted on the Town website.

The selected firm must meet all municipal, state, and federal AA and EEO practices and requirements. MBE's, WBE's, SBE's are encouraged to apply. The Town reserves the right to reject any or all proposals in whole or part, to award any one service or group of services or all services, to negotiate with any or all companies submitting proposals, and to enter into an agreement with any contractor for any services mentioned in this RFP; if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.
