ROSEVILLE WINTER OPEN CHESS TOURNAMENT

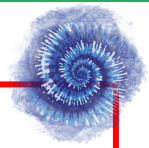

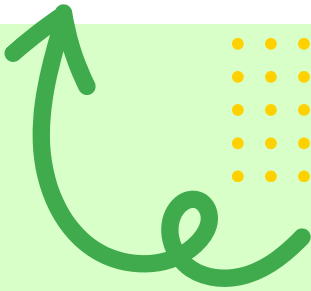

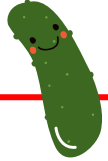
