

## WHAT IS NC MTSS?

Family engagement within an MTSS is defined as the active and meaningful partnerships that educators build and maintain with students' families for the purpose of supporting student learning. It embodies the idea that all parties are equally invested in the student's educational experience and all parties bring knowledge and skills of equal value to the table to work together.

## WHAT IS SUPPORT?

NC schools that are implementing an MTSS may talk about support for students. To further define that support, NC organizes these supports around the instruction, the curriculum, and the environment.

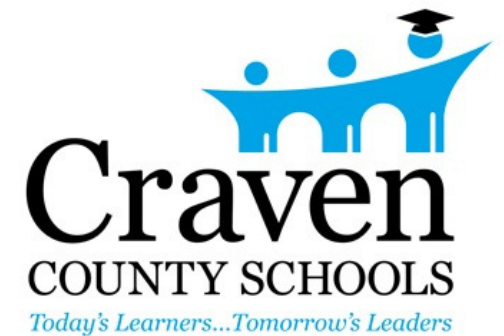

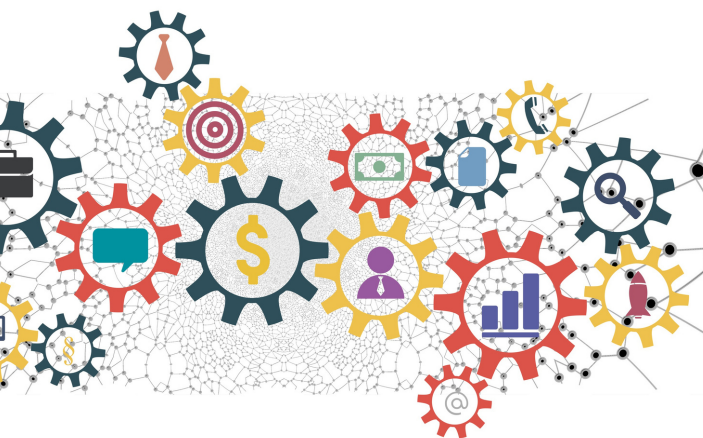

## A FRAMEWORK



NC MTSS is a multi-tiered framework which promotes school improvement through engaging, research-based academic and behavioral practices.

NC MTSS employs a systems approach using data-driven problem-solving to maximize growth for all.

## ALL STUDENTS



All students will receive evidence-based instructional supports in academic, behavior, and social emotional practices based on students' needs.

## ALL STAFF

All staff will be supported around instruction, curriculum, and environment to ensure practices are being used effectively.

## ALL FAMILIES



MTSS is a school improvement framework. A high level of family involvement is one of the common characteristics of high performing schools. (Henderson & Mapp, 2002)
