### Update on Safety Protocols Regarding Masks Outdoors



Executive Order 309 went into effect Friday, April 30th at 5:00 pm. Please see the following excerpt from the new order:

WHEREAS, in light of the continued measured progress the state has achieved in its key COVID-19 metrics, and the reduced risk of transmission of the virus in outdoor settings, particularly among fully vaccinated individuals, **the**

state can lift, at this time, the requirement to wear a Face Covering in outdoor settings when social distancing of six (6) feet cannot be maintained; and

WHEREAS, North Carolinians are encouraged to wear Face Coverings outdoors in certain crowded, dense, and higher-risk settings when they cannot consistently maintain six ( 6) feet of social distance from non-household members;

Beginning Monday, May 3, students and staff are permitted to be outside with masks off *only* if they can maintain six (6) feet of physical distance. Any student or staff member must continue wearing a mask until they have completely exited the building and place it back on before returning inside. However, anyone who wants to continue to wear a face-covering outdoors should feel free to do so and will be supported by all individuals in our schools.

**Craven COUNTY SCHOOLS COVID-19 Communications Protocol**

The following notification protocol will be utilized when a school is notified of a staff member or student who has tested positive for COVID-19, and the case is considered to be school impacted. Craven County Schools, in partnership with the Craven County Health Department, follows the communications guidance from the NC Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS).

A school impacted case is one in which the individual was in a school building, less than 6 feet from others for 15 minutes or longer. "Close contact" refers to the individual being less than 6 feet away from others for a total of 15 minutes or more.

Close contact staff members and parents of students identified as close contacts will be notified by phone directly by the school nurse. Directions on how to proceed will be provided based on guidance from the Craven County Health Department in conjunction with NC Department of Health and Human Services.

Staff members and parents of students at the individual school who were not in close contact with the individual will be notified of the school-affected positive case by the school administrator through a letter distributed by email and BlackBoard.

A dashboard will be created displaying the district data of NEW positive cases. This will be updated at 5pm on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday of each week.

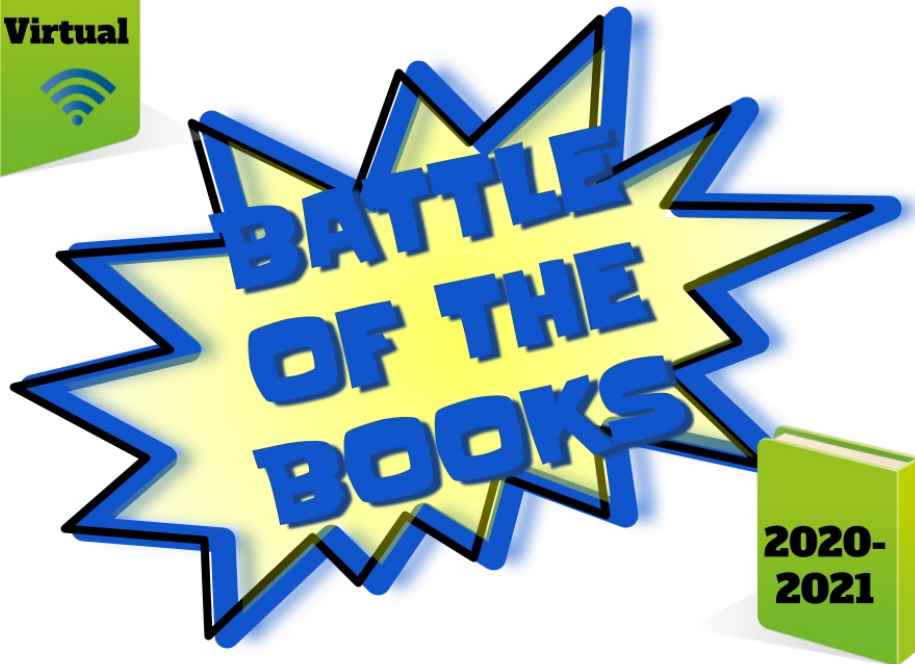
