**A School-Parent Compact is an agreement that families, students, and teachers develop together. It explains how families and teachers will work together to make sure all students reach grade level standards.**

### **Effective Compacts**

- Link goals to the School Improvement Plan
- Focus on student learning skills
- Describe how the school will help students develop skills using high tech instruction
- Share strategies that families can use at home
- Explain how teachers and families will communicate about student progress

## ***Parent Involvement Activities***

**Fall Meeting** - Held in Sept/Oct each year, school data is shared with and explained to families.

**Reading Night** - Students spend time with their families and teachers having fun with reading activities in November.

**Math Night** - Students spend time with their families and teachers using math in real world situations. Join us at a local grocery store in January.

**Science Night** - Students and their families participate in hands-on science experiments. We do ours in conjunction with the NC Science Festival in April.
