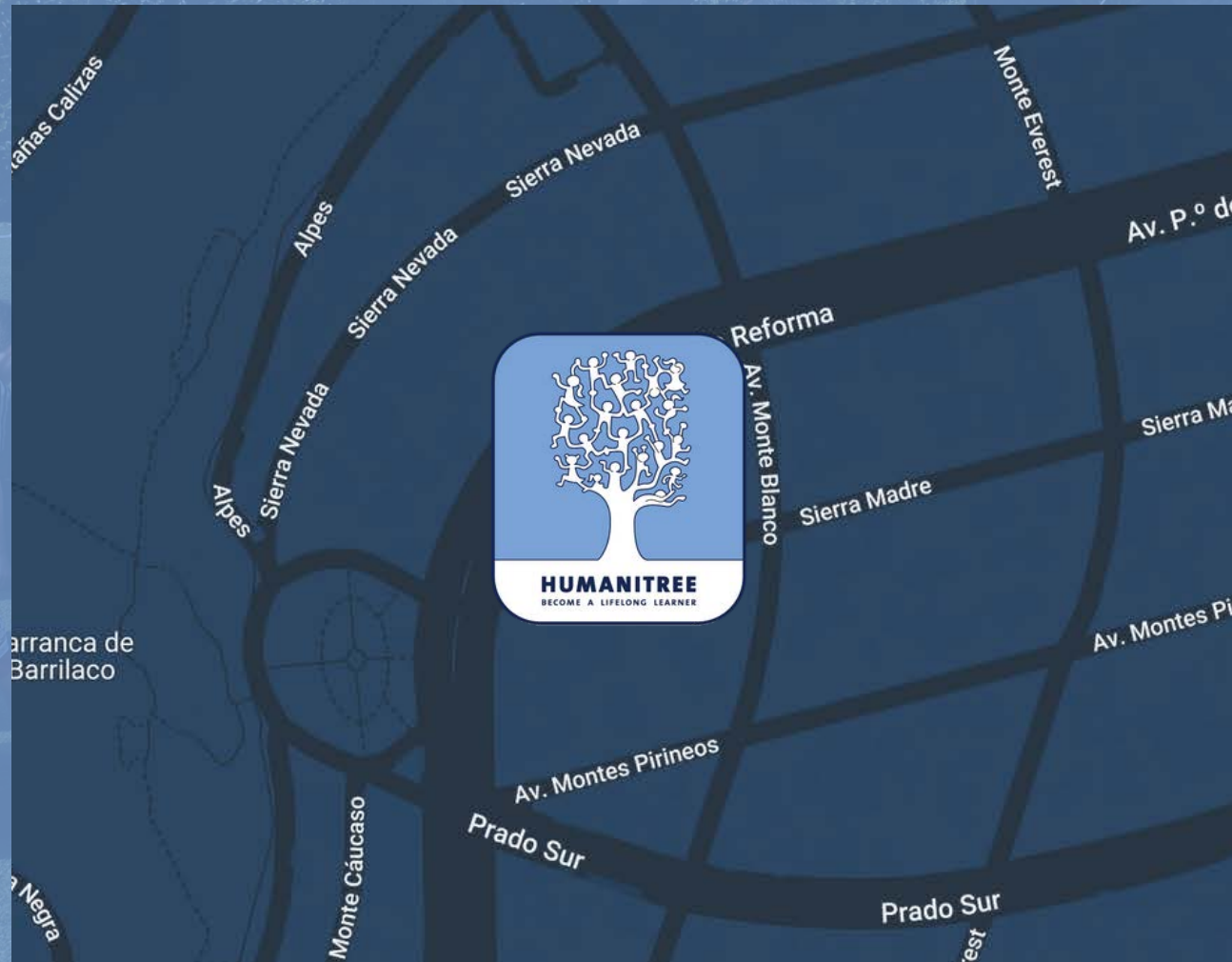

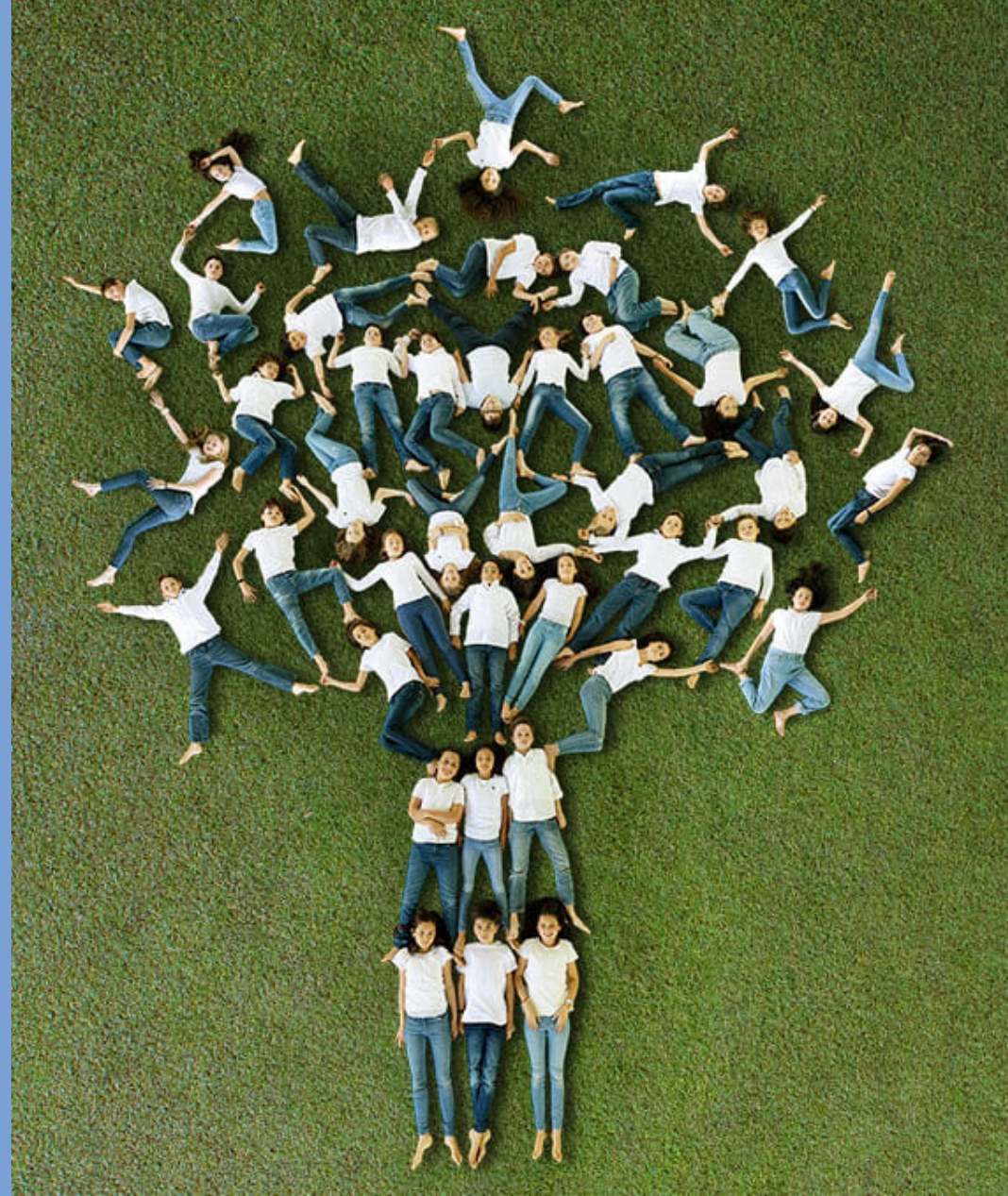

AGE EQUIVALENT: 2-5 YEAR OLDS



Nest is the name we give to the space designed for our younger children. It is where the little ones are nurtured and protected until they are ready to fly by themselves. This part of the school allows children to enjoy a caring, secure and exciting environment. Through play and exploration, they gain the confidence to develop and discover their potential.

In Nest, children acquire the basic skills that prepare them to move from concrete to more abstract ways of thinking. Through our approach, children explore and develop a deeper understanding of the world they live in and share with others.



CURRICULUM

In Nest, we have a comprehensive curriculum where most content areas are taught through Project Based Learning. Curricular threads emerge from the interests of the children and form projects through which other areas of learning are integrated.





NEST LITERACY

Nest children learn to love Literacy through literature, singing songs, rhymes and imaginative play. Children learn phonics and emergent writing skills through a multi-sensory method. They have access to over 15,000 different text titles in the library and have an online reading account in Nest 3.

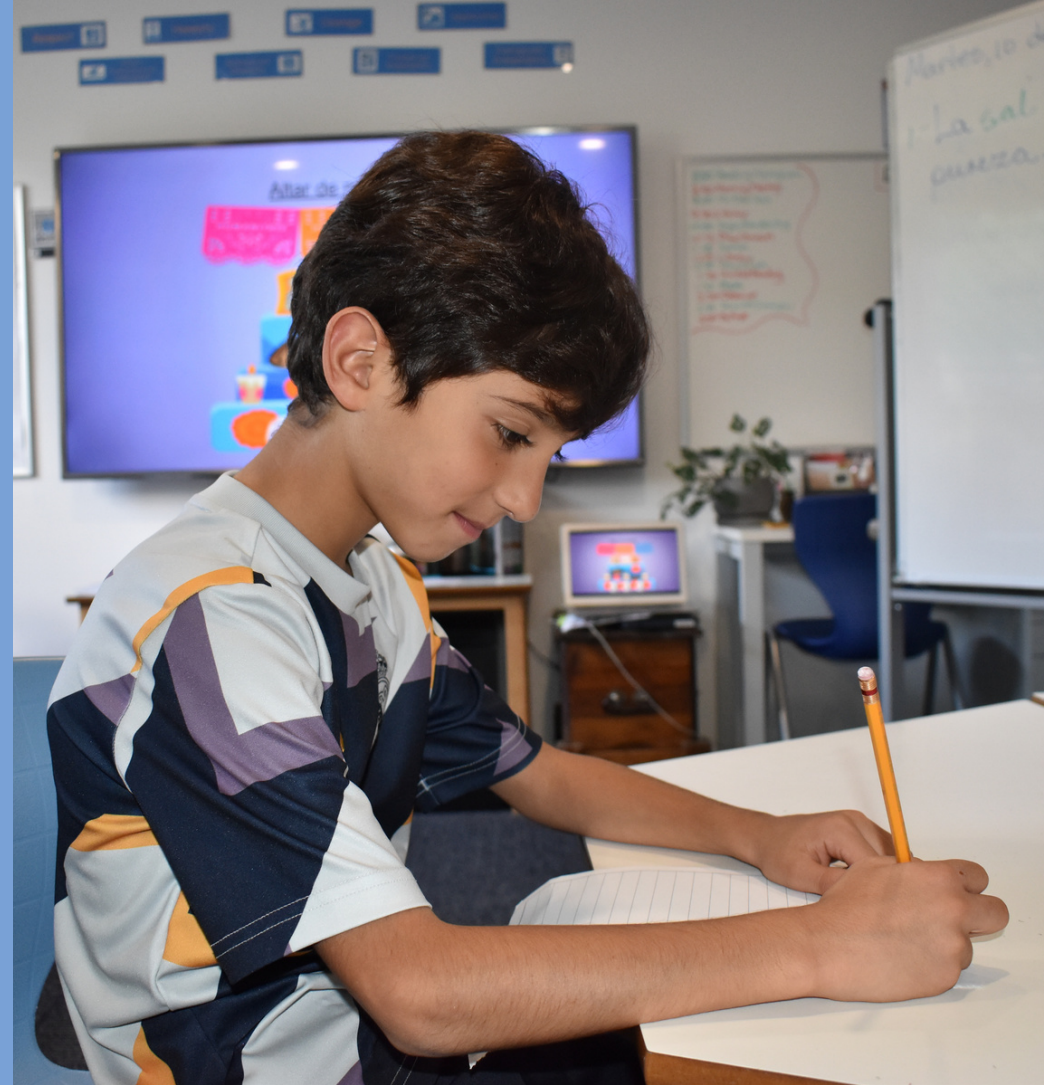
WELCOME TO **BLOOM**

Bloom is the elementary school section of Humanitree. This is an exciting, collaborative and creative place where children experience challenge and success. They gain confidence and understanding through a varied curriculum developing independence with many opportunities to express themselves in diverse ways.

In Bloom, the concepts and objectives are more complex. Our methods encourage children to have fun while learning; the ideas they develop are more challenging and technical, evolved by divergent thinking. Through our approach, children investigate ideas on both local and global scales, looking outside their immediate day-to-day lives to reflect and explore their feelings and perceptions.





BLOOM LITERACY

The key Literacy skills are developed and supported by Big Write and Letters & Sounds for phonics.

A progressive levelled reading scheme with texts from a range of publishers is complemented by an extensive collection of books for Guided Reading to develop reading comprehension skills.
