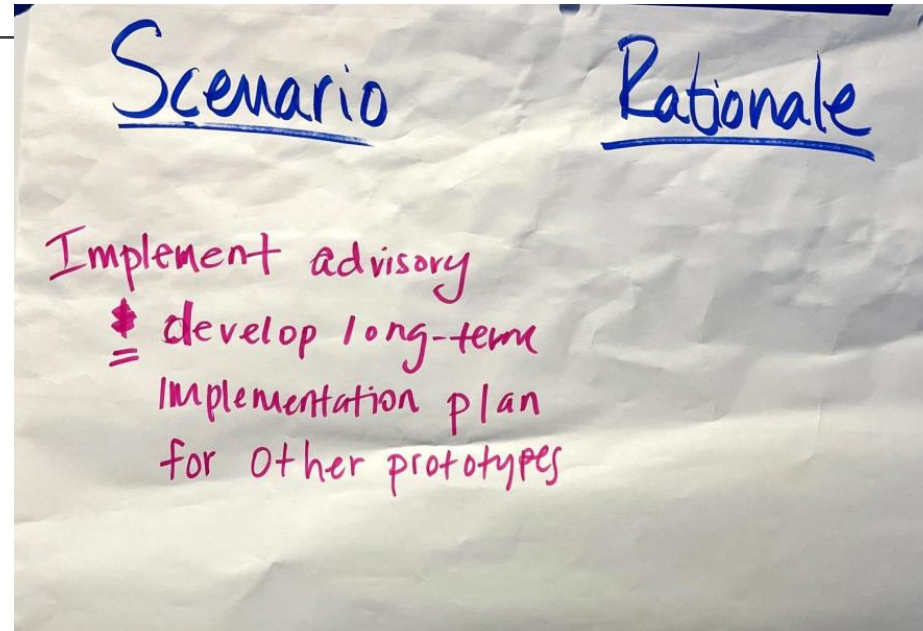
# Summary of Stakeholder Perception by Prototype

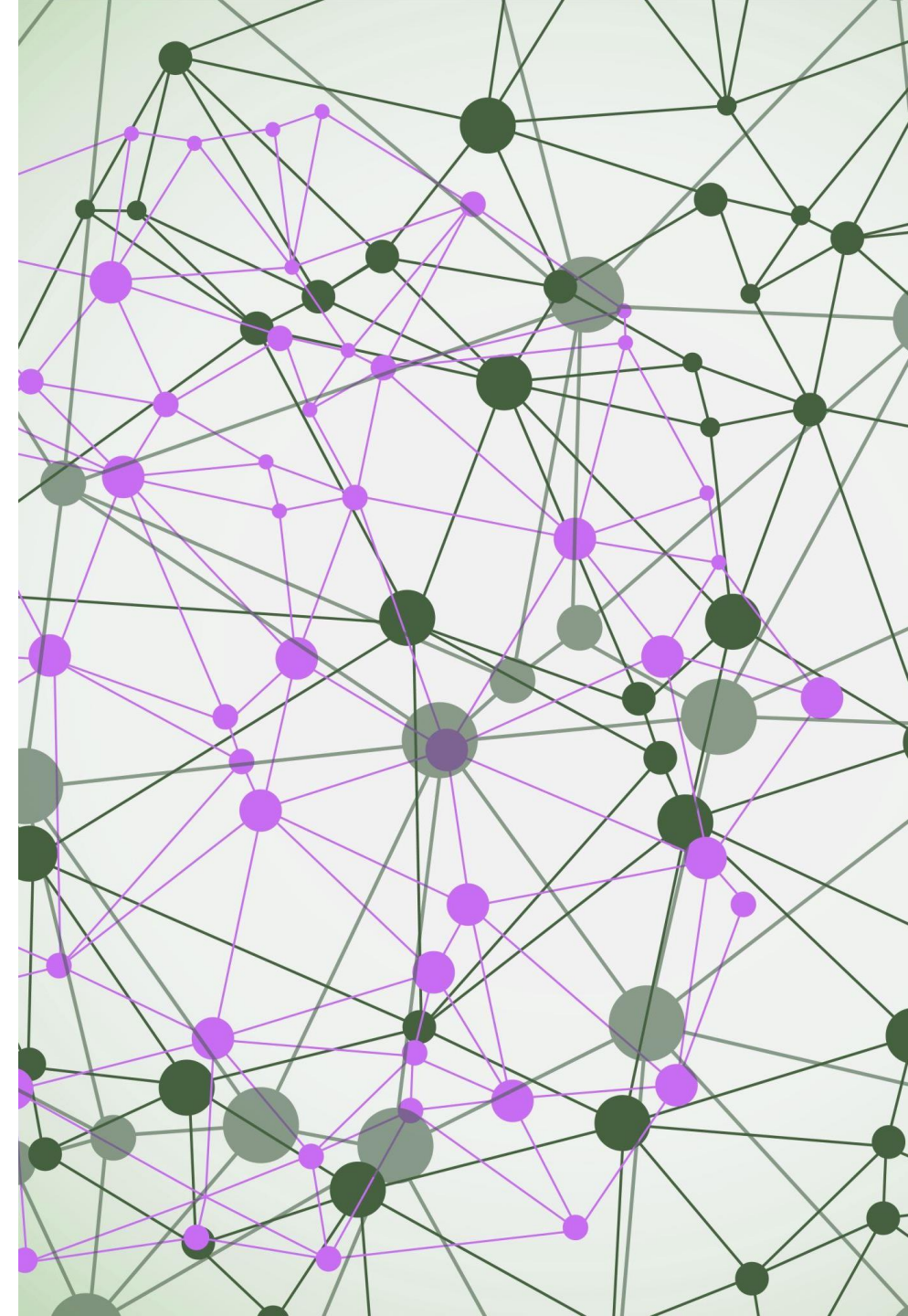

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## RECOMMENDATIONS (To be finalized)

After understanding the needs of students and defining the opportunity, the next step was to establish a shared vision for what an improved middle school experience would entail. The team collaboratively created a vision that involves redesigning the middle school education to prioritize students' needs and development. This vision is grounded in relationships, caters to students' social and emotional needs, and offers an interactive learning environment. Additionally, it serves as a bridge between elementary and high school. The RMS Steering Committee devised three scenarios that include **three prototypes: Advisory/Homeroom, Teacher Teams and Problem-Based Learning.**

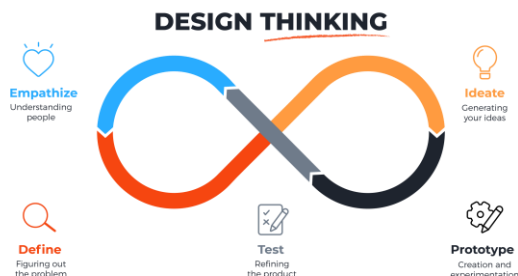
