

COBIS Music Festival 2024 – Online Competition Terms and Conditions

The COBIS Music Festival 2024 (online competition) will be hosted by British School of Bahrain.

Registration

- The Music Festival (online competition) is open to COBIS member schools, including Applicant and Provisional schools. Each school with a registered COBIS account should participate as an individual school.
- Attendees must register for the competition via the online form on the COBIS website.
- The closing date for registration is 26 October 2023.
- The online Music Festival is open to students in Years 6-13.
- Those in Years 6-9 must enter the 'Lower School' categories and those in Years 10-13 must enter the 'Upper School' categories.

Submitting Entries

- Submissions will be open from the 1 November 2023 – 15 December 2023.
- Students should enter their category with a recording (audio or video) of the composition (either of someone playing it or from score writing software) and a score/commentary.
- Entries should not be longer than 4 minutes. If an entry exceeds 4 minutes, only the first 4 minutes will be judged.
- Schools should take responsibility for the filming of entries where possible.
- Entries must be submitted by a teacher on behalf of the student to their designated folder on the [Music Festival website](#). More information on the submission process will be published early December 2023.
- All teachers should have the correct permissions from parents/guardians to share their pupils' names, ages and video footage as part of this competition.
- Each student may enter a maximum of one category. COBIS and British School of Bahrain reserve the right to remove subsequent submissions from the judging process.
- Please note, schools must pay their invoice in a timely manner, otherwise their entries will be disqualified.
- The competition categories include:

Upper School

- Free Composition
- Film Composition – clip provided by British School of Bahrain
- Electronic Music
- Songwriting

Lower School

- Free Composition
- Film Composition – clip provided by British School of Bahrain
- Electronic Music
- Songwriting

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- Please ensure entries are submitted to the correct category. Entries will not be accepted if they are submitted to the wrong category.
- The following timeline will be adhered to:

1 November 2023	Submissions open
15 December 2023	Submissions close
11 February 2024	Winners announced

- A winner will be selected from each category, along with an overall Young Composer of the Year.

Finance

- The cost to enter the competition is £45 per student.
- Invoices will be issued by British School of Bahrain during the week commencing 29 October 2023.
- Schools must pay the participation fee in a timely manner, in accordance with the timeline specified on the invoice. If a school does not pay their fee by the date shown on the invoice, their place in the competition will be revoked.

Cancellation

- COBIS and British School of Bahrain reserve the right to cancel this competition if insufficient registrations are received, or if circumstances do not allow a virtual competition to take place.

COBIS Code of Conduct

By participating in a COBIS Student Event, individuals agree to abide by the Code of Conduct as outlined below. Data Sharing and Processing

- In order to administer this event, COBIS and British School of Bahrain will collect the following information:
 - **Students:** name, age, year group, and entry
 - **Teacher:** Head teacher name, booking coordinator name, email and job title, finance contact name and email
- This data will be shared between COBIS and British School of Bahrain for the administration and delivery of the event. COBIS and British School of Bahrain will have a data sharing agreement in place to protect the transfer of this information. Competition entries will be shared with the judges; all other personal information will not be passed by COBIS or British School of Bahrain to any other parties.
- The full name, age, school name and entries of participants may be published on the COBIS and British School of Bahrain website and social media. This information may also be published and promoted at the COBIS Annual Conference in May 2024 and in other COBIS-related publications. Participants should participate in such reasonable promotional activity and material as COBIS may require. By entering the competition, the teacher confirms that the necessary permissions have been sought from students and/or their parents to publish this information for such purposes.
- COBIS will retain data and information in line with their [Privacy Policy](#). The host school will retain data and information in line with their [Data Protection Policy](#).
