



Decorating Hazards and How to Prevent Them

Fires

- Declutter. Do not block fire exits, alarms, sprinkler heads, vents, or radiators with decorations. Never use candles or any décor with heating elements. Choose décors with flame-resistant coatings.

Trips

- Put all unused decorations in boxes and store them properly inside cabinets. Leaving boxes and loose cables on the floor can cause tripping hazards.

Cuts

- Use only shatterproof, unbreakable decorations. To avoid cuts, be careful when working with foil, paper, staples, and strings.

Poisoning

- Avoid candy-like decorations; some may be made with substances that could be toxic if swallowed. Keep decorations out of children's reach.

Falls

- Secure all decorations properly using the right fasteners based on their weight.
