Programs

A child is eligible for enrollment in Head Start if the child is four years old on or before September 1 of the current school year and meets income guidelines (poverty level or below as defined by Federal Poverty Guidelines). A child with disabilities may also qualify.

A child is eligible for Pre-Kindergarten if a child is at least four years of age and is:

1. Unable to speak and comprehend the English language:
2. Educationally disadvantaged: or
3. Homeless, as defined by federal law [see FD (LEGAL)], regardless of the residence of the child, of either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person having lawful control.

Guidelines

If deemed eligible for selection in Head Start, the child will be served in the Head Start program. If Head Start is fully enrolled, the child will be placed on the Head Start waiting list and served in Pre-Kindergarten. When a slot becomes available in Head Start, the child will be withdrawn from Pre-Kindergarten and placed in a Head Start classroom.
