Grades earned through correspondence, summer school, co-enrollment courses, TxVSN, credit-by-examination, and at the middle school level will not be included in class rank nor GPA.

TRANSFER COURSES

Course credits earned by a transfer student in their previous school will be reviewed by the student's counselor to determine, based on EIC (Legal, Local, and Reg.), which courses on the student's transcript qualify for inclusion in the student's GPA calculation and which courses, if any, qualify for additional weighted points. If there are any questions regarding whether or not a course's curriculum is aligned to Tivy High School's level of rigor, the transcript will be presented to THS's Transcript Evaluation Committee for review and determination. The committee is comprised of: the Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction, the Academic Dean, relevant Teachers, the student's Counselor and the Lead Counselor.

MODIFIED COURSES

Courses, where the required content of the TEKS are modified by the student's ARD committee and are reflected in the IEP, shall not earn the same number of grade points as on-level courses.
