Disciplinary Alternative School: Elementary Students

Elementary Student Placement Students who commit an offense, which qualifies him or her (according to the *KISD Student Code of Conduct Handbook*) for Disciplinary Alternative School placement, will be sent to the *In-School-Suspension* room on another elementary campus within the district.

Chronic Offenses and Threat to Safety However, if the behavior is chronic or considered a safety threat, the student will be sent (accompanied by a campus instructional aide) to the district's Disciplinary Alternative School. The aide will work under the direction of the student's teacher and under the supervision of the Disciplinary Alternative School's administrator. The instructional aide and the student will be separated from older students on the campus. Counseling services for the student and the student's parents should be strongly considered as a tool in preventing repeated offenses and transitioning the student back to the home campus.
