Re: School Health Advisory Council Activity Report for 2017-2018

Texas Education Code directs the local School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) to submit an annual report to the board of trustees as an explanation of the SHAC's activities during the school year. Below is a description of the activities of the Kerrville ISD SHAC in 2017-2018.

The SHAC, comprised of parents, community members, and District staff, met four times to learn about and respond to topics of interest as they relate to critical components of the Coordinated School Health program in Kerrville ISD. Each topic was presented by Wade Ivy, Assistant Superintendent of Administration & Human Resources, and allowed for a lively discussion designed to highlight areas of strength and weakness. The topics consisted of:

- *District Wellness Plan Update*
- *District of Innovation*
- *Random Drug Testing of Students at Tivy High School*
- *Long-Range Facilities Planning (Phase I and II)*
- *School Safety – Retooling District Responses to Crises*

The School Health Advisory Council's attendees had the opportunity to make meaningful contributions to the topics, to serve on committees related to the topics, and to share their new knowledge with the wider community.
