## **Knightstown Community High School PLATO Guidelines**

PLATO will be used primarily as a credit recovery option to be used during summer school

During the school year (Aug-May), PLATO course(s) will only be assigned if:

- 1) A senior needs a course for graduation with no other options available
  - 2) A senior needs a course in order to earn an Academic Honors Diploma
  - 3) A senior needs a course to earn a Core 40 Diploma
  - 4) A vocational student is unable to schedule a required or needed course and cannot fit the course into his/her schedule prior to graduation; this will only apply in the case that the student cannot complete the course during summer school and has been accepted into a vocational program.
  - 5) A student requests to retake a course(s) to improve GPA, and no other options are available. In this case, a course must be completed prior to another course being assigned. This option only applies to seniors.
- Each student will only select one course to complete during summer school. This course must be completed prior to any additional courses being assigned.
  - Students must take all pre-tests, post-tests, and final exams at the high school under staff supervision
  - Students who are applying for early graduation (by January of the student's junior year), must complete the needed PLATO courses during summer school
  - PLATO courses taken during summer school must be completed prior to the end of summer school (three week timeframe)
