Course Planning and Requirements

How do I register for classes?

- 1. Fill-in the high school courses you will have completed by the end of the current year.
- 2. Read the Graduation Requirements chart to determine courses you still need to take.
- 3. Consider course needed for college and career readiness goals.
- 4. Review the course descriptions, prerequisites, and grade level restrictions.
- 5. List the course you want to take next year on your Course Planning Worksheet (back of this document).
- 6. List alternate courses (electives) in case your first choices are not available.

How many credits do I need to graduate?

You need 66 credits from 9th-12th grade. Successful completion of each trimester course earns you 1 credit. Each trimester you have the ability to earn a total of 6 credits: totaling 18.25 per year.
