Creative Media 1 – 92509*

Semester-long course, 0.5 credit

Take on the role of an interviewer, music producer, podcaster, radio DJ, and sports play by play announcer in real world settings. Develop digital audio editing to be utilized in a variety of audio related careers.

Creative Media 2 – 92519*

Semester-long course, 0.5 credit

Become an influencer! Learn advanced skills as you produce podcasts, radio spots, music, sound for film, and create a unique on-air radio personality. Learn through hands-on experiences (simulated and live) applied to the Twin Cities radio, podcast, and audio industries. Learn to solve the daily challenges involved in running sound, broadcasts and music recordings in this project driven course.

Digital Photography – 92606*

Semester-long course, 0.5 credit

Like to take pictures and focus in on the details of life? Explore how to take great pictures that tell a story. Explore camera features, principles of studio and natural lighting, image composition, on-location and studio shooting, in-camera image manipulation, and how to catalog and manage your images.

Advanced Photography & Editing – 92616*

Semester-long course, 0.5 credit

Expand your digital photography skills to include creative image editing and creative composition. Learn to manipulate and prepare images for commercial print and digital use; includes intro to story concept, video production, and 3D animation.

Adobe Photoshop – 92406AO*

Semester-long course, 0.5 credit

Build a portfolio of digital designs aligned and express your creativity while you learn common features and uses of Adobe Photoshop. Create original artwork, manipulate color images, retouch photographs and explore how you can apply these skills in a variety of media arts career opportunities.

Digital Video 1 – 92709*

Semester-long course, 0.5 credit

Interested in expressing yourself through film and video? Learn all phases of video production, including pre- and post-production, while you create digital video; feature length films, shorts, YouTube, animation and stop-motion videos. Plan, record, and edit videos using digital cameras and professional software.

Digital Video 2 – 92719*

Semester-long course, 0.5 credit

Expand your video production skills and develop advanced technical knowledge of camera operation, audio recording, lighting, visual effects, graphics, and copyright laws. Learn to write copy, storyboard, create characters, and add visual effects.

Adobe Illustrator – 92416AO*

Semester-long course, 0.5 credit

Explore the world of graphic design and learn the principal vector drawing software used in logos, branding, and multimedia. Use Adobe Illustrator to create your own artwork, learn color theory, drawing and composition, typography and quality file management skills.
