

MVHS Choir Code of Conduct

In order to provide a safe and enjoyable trip for everyone involved, every participant must follow a code of conduct. This code is to be read, signed and must be returned before the trip departure.

1. State liquor laws require a person to be 21 years of age to drink alcoholic beverages: I, therefore, agree not to purchase, attempt to purchase, consume or have in my possession any alcoholic beverages.
2. I, will refrain from the use or possession of any type of drug, other than prescription drugs, which I have informed the sponsors in writing.
3. I agree to not smoke including electronic and vapor cigarettes at any time while on the trip.
4. I fully understand that all hotel rooms for students are not coeducational and I further understand that only those students actually assigned to a hotel room are to be in that room.
5. I agree to pay jointly, with the other members assigned to my hotel room, for any expenses occurring because of breakage and/or loss or items from and in my assigned hotel room.
6. I agree to never swim alone, day or night.
7. For reasons of safety, I agree to be with a group of three (or more) other students or in the company of sponsors at all times. I further agree to go nowhere alone, even inside the hotel.
8. I agree to become aware of, and abide by all curfew regulations.
9. I will refrain from any and all types of behavior, which is unacceptable to the directors, or sponsors that would bring discredit to Mill Valley High School and USD #232.

I fully understand that for any violation of the above items/ but not limited to the above items, the trip leaders and/or sponsors have the following right:

"Violations of major school rules will result in the offender's immediate return home if at all possible. Any extra expense for returning a student early for disciplinary reasons will be the responsibility of the parent(s) guardian. The trip leaders or sponsors shall have full discretionary authority to determine if a code of conduct violation is serious enough to require the student who violates the code to be immediately sent home. Any violation by a student of Rules, 1,2, and 3 shall be deemed to be in violation of a major school disciplinary rule and the student who violates any of said rules shall immediately be sent home unless the entire band will be returning home within twenty-four hours.

I fully realize that any major infringement such as stated above can also result in suspension or expulsion from school, since the Band Trip is a school sponsored activity.

I acknowledge that I freely and voluntarily sign this agreement in regard to my conduct and that I have read it completely and fully understand it.
