Instruction

HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS (HIV) RELATED INSTRUCTION IN THE CLASSROOM

Pursuant to Board Policy 8210, the District will provide all students with a health education program including instruction on AIDS and methods of prevention. Students whose parents submit a written request to the principal will be excluded from receiving classroom instruction regarding "method of prevention" of HIV/AIDS. Instead, parents will be responsible for providing such instruction. In such cases:

1. The principal will provide instructional material on "methods of prevention" of HIV/AIDS to parents/guardians who request exclusion from instruction. These materials will be appropriate for home instruction.
2. Excluded students will be provided with alternative curriculum by the teacher during the period of exclusion from instruction on "methods of prevention" of HIV/AIDS, but will not be exempt from testing on all aspects of HIV/AIDS instruction, including "methods of prevention."
