Rolling Report

- The rolling report is still being tweaked for FY24 to ensure accuracy. As soon as the July report is available, I will send it out via email.
- The next five are a printout from the software as verification of numbers.

Board Report pg.1

- This continues to be a more detailed recap of the rolling report.
 - o Overall, we spent nearly \$250,000 more than we took in for the month.
 - This basically amounts to the HSA dollars for staff.
 - o Encumbrances remain high which is typical for this time of year.
 - o Outstanding invoices have settled around \$1 million.
 - Most of which were issued in the last couple of weeks.

District/County pg.2

- New amounts have been loaded into their budgets.
- Working on a spend-down plan that will be rolled out in January.

Investments pg.2

- We added another \$8,000 to our money market by way of interest this month.
- We have our first CD on the books in quite some time.
 - o \$250,000 Brokered CD with a maturity of 7/26/2027

All Other Funds pg.3

- We've Grown!
 - o FY24 grants have been added to take us to three sheets.

Three-Year Comparison pg.4

- The significant uptick from FY23 to FY24 revenue amounts is due to the delay in Foundation receipts in FY23.
- Expenses were higher in the month of July of the prior year because it was a three-pay month.

Final Notes

- We are planning on break-even this year as the worst-case scenario.
- There are a number of large expenses on the horizon.
- Revenue will continue to lag as it does each year during this time.
 - o Foundation contracts will continue to carry us financially until we get to October.
