

Volunteers / Background Checks

For volunteers, partners, or field trip chaperones who will not be under line-of-sight supervision by BVSD staff at all times - CBI fingerprint check required through a third-party vendor, paid by the volunteer/partner/school AND volunteer must sign a BVSD volunteer agreement.
