IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE HEALTH ROOM

Medications at School

Medications are seldom necessary for students during the school day. For those students who need to take ANY medication during the school day (whether over the counter or prescribed by a doctor); State Law requires:

- BVSD Medication Authorization Form be completed and signed by a parent/guardian and the child's physician.
- Medication with correct dosage in the pharmacy bottle/package (must be original containers.)

Medications MUST be kept in the health room. AT NO TIME are medication(s) to be kept in lockers or carried by a student.

Soles4Souls utilizes new and gently used shoes as a resource to help entrepreneurs in developing nations with an opportunity to start and sustain small businesses (40pportunity) of their own. Accepted: New or gently used shoes off all kinds.

Not Accepted: Dirty, ripped, or torn shoes.

Please:

- · Pair and drop clean shoes in the marked boxes.
- Tie or band the pairs.
- · Avoid putting the shoes in a plastic bag.

Unusable shoes are NOT being recycled and will go to the landfill. Please make sure all donated shoes are in useable condition and can be upcycled to others.
