LIBRARY TIME

Students will visit the library each week during a scheduled time with their class. They will be able to check out books, listen to stories, participate in fun activities, and learn about how libraries work.

OPEN HOURS

If a student finishes their book before their scheduled library time, there are open hours that they may visit during to return their book(s) and check out a new one.

BOOK CHECKOUTS

Kindergarten* Limited to 2
1st Grade books at a time.

2nd Grade Limited to 3
3rd Grade books at a time.

4th Grade May have up to 5
5th Grade books at a time.

*Kindergarten students do not bring their library books home. If you see one, please send it back to school! Thank you.

LOST BOOKS

If a book is lost, remind your student not to panic and that honesty is always the best policy. Most books are not lost, simply misplaced. Check your car, backpack, and places you frequently visit. If you truly feel it is gone for good, let me know and we can work out the best possible solution together.

DAMAGED BOOKS

If a book is damaged, don't panic. Place it in a bag and send it back to the library. *Please* do not attempt to repair the damage on your own. I will assess the damage once the book is returned and may be able to repair it!
