III. President's Report by Jeff Gulan

A. Recognition of Fall athletic teams and All-Conference winners

- B. Sarah Keene gave a report on Winter Wonderland #35
 - a. Both attendance and results continue to be strong
 - b. Over \$242,000 gross income
 - c. \$62,450 for Fund-A-Need (funding specials-art, foods, etc.)
 - d. Remainder of net income will be used for operating budget
- C. Advancement is working on estate building good forward movement
 - a. Funds are non-restricted
- D. Finance is working on budget adjustments to compensate for falling enrollment
- E. The HVAC project
 - a. Is on budget
 - b. Will be completed ahead of schedule Summer 2023
- F. Curriculum responsibility has been delegated to the principals since Amy Mettlach's passing

- B. Accreditation with WRISA needs to be completed by end of 2023-2034 school year
 - 1. Presentation of process will be given at January 16 In-service
 - 2. A portion of January In-service will be dedicated to the work
 - 3. Individual schools will be accredited selected teachers will work on their school
 - 4. Accreditation is good for 7 years
 - 5. NCS pays for accreditation, plus accommodation/meals for the team
 - 6. Other expenses will be any changes needed (i.e. programs, etc)
- C. Enrollment
 - 1. Numbers are below projected biggest drops at the transition grades (PreK-K, 5th-6th, 8th-9th), other impacts were families moving out of area
 - a. Planning for promoting NCS in 4K programs
- D. Consideration for piloting an NCS 4K program at St. Mark
 - a. Survey sent to 38 parents as first step
 - b. Current 4K students are part of the public school and religion cannot be taught as part of the curriculum
 - c. Tuition would be close to Kindergarten rate; students would be eligible for WPCP
 - d. Discussion regarding all day, 5 days/week vs. half days or 3 days/week options
- E. Classical School Father Sam Martin
 - a. At this point: pursuing the possibility and praying for God's will.
 - b. Reaches students we are not reaching now
 - c. Teaches Greek, Latin, Western Civilization, etc.
 - d. Funding is available private schools are usually self-sufficient in 3 years
