
## FOCUS

If you are still struggling to get on focus, please visit the lake county website <https://www.lake.k12.fl.us/focus>. There are helpful tools and information for accessing focus. The **RED HELP** button will generate a google form for you to fill out with the county. FOCUS help desk is quick to respond via email. If you are unable to resolve the problem via email, the helpdesk will call the parent directly.

If you are not enabled and still need to be verified, you will need to stop by the front office with their ID.

While we do not have a focus app, it is being worked on and hopefully will be available in October. All students are considered full pay regardless of their prior year approvals. A NEW application must be submitted and approved for the 23/24 school year.
