





Now is a great time to be sure that you are caught up in your classes and getting any additional help that you might need to improve your grades or stay on track. Please use your resources if you need help! Speak to your teachers, form a study group with peers, talk to your counselor. Teachers and Counselors are available during Access time every Thursday morning from 8:35am - 9:30am. National Honor Society tutors are available in the Fairview Resource Center in the library (let your counselor know if you would like to sign up for a tutor).

Additionally, just a reminder that deadlines are still approaching...Early Action and Early Decision college application deadlines are 11/15 and the UC and Cal State application deadlines are 11/30.
