HUM 1003: Introduction to Film Art (taught in Spanish)

Introduces film terminology and narrative techniques to explore how film conveys meaning and to study the relationships among film form, content, and audience reception. This course emphasizes active viewing, discussion, and critical analysis of films from different cultures and eras. This is a statewide Guaranteed Transfer course in the GT-AH2 category. Since this course is taught in Spanish, students who participate must possess strong listening, speaking, reading and writing skills in Spanish. The ideal students for this course are those who have completed all levels of Spanish offered at our school and/or those who have received previous content instruction in Spanish through our BVSD dual language programs or content instruction in a Spanish speaking country.

BVSD is excited to offer this content course in Spanish as a start to a larger scale initiative to offer concurrent enrollment for our biliterate learners. Please, keep an eye out for additional opportunities as we work to fully develop a partnership with Front Range Community College.



Grad+ Overview and Sign up for District Select Courses!


