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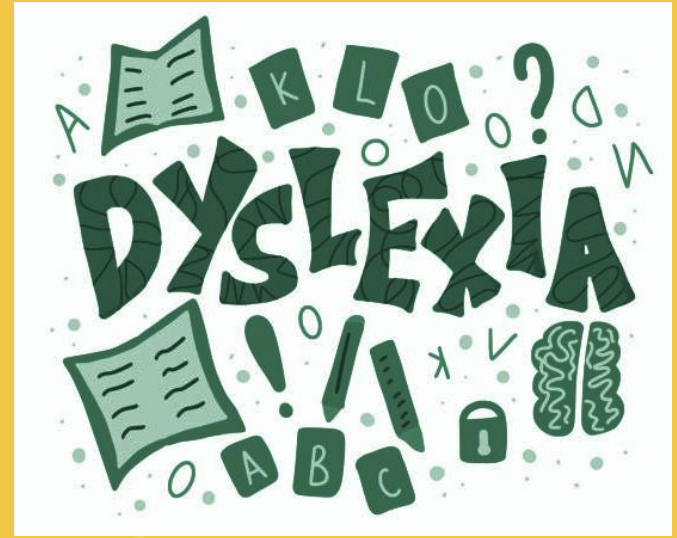

What is dyslexia? / ¿Qué es la dislexia?



Dyslexia is an *unexpected* difficulty in reading in an individual who has the intelligence to be a much better reader.



La dislexia es una dificultad *inesperada* en la lectura en una persona que tiene la inteligencia para leer mucho mejor.

Definition of dyslexia / Definición de dislexia



Developmental **dyslexia** is a specific **learning disability** which involves a disorder in **reading, spelling, and writing**.

- Can be passed from parent to child

La **dislexia** del desarrollo es una **discapacidad específica** del aprendizaje que implica un trastorno **en la lectura, la ortografía y la escritura**.

- Puede transmitirse de padres a hijos.★



Dyslexia Characteristics

- Speaking delays
- Difficult remembering names of familiar objects
- Difficulties learning nursery rhymes
- Other family members have similar difficulties

Características de la dislexia

- Retrasos en el habla
- Dificultad para recordar nombres de objetos familiares.
- Dificultades para aprender canciones infantiles.
- Otros miembros de la familia tienen dificultades similares.

Dyslexia Characteristics

- Reading errors that show no connection to the sounds of the letters on the page—will say “puppy” instead of the written word “dog” on an illustrated page with a picture of a dog
- Does not understand that words come apart
- Complains about how hard reading is; “disappears” when it is time to read
- Cannot sound out even simple words like *cat*, *map*, *nap*
- Does not associate letters with sounds, such as the letter b with the “b” sound

Características de la dislexia

- Errores de lectura que no muestran conexión con los sonidos de las letras de la página: dicen “cachorro” en lugar de la palabra escrita “perro” en una página ilustrada con la imagen de un perro.
- No entiende que las palabras se separan
- Se queja de lo difícil que es leer; “desaparece” cuando llega el momento de leer
- No puedo pronunciar ni siquiera palabras simples como gato, mapa, siesta. 
- No asociar letras con sonidos, como la letra b con el sonido “b”

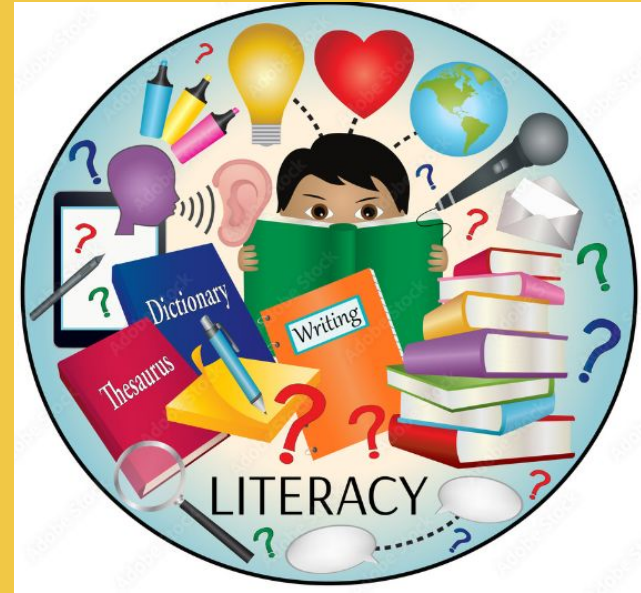
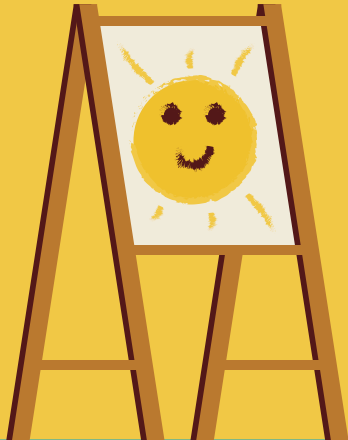

Subtypes of Dyslexia / Subtipos de dislexia

Subtype / Subtipos	Characteristics / Características
Phonological / Fonológico	This type of dyslexia involves a difficulty with syllabic reading / Este tipo de dislexia implica una dificultad con la lectura silábica
Orthographic / Ortografico	Difficulties when reading irregular, arbitrary or homophone words / Dificultades al leer palabras irregulares arbitrarias o homófonas
Mixed / Mezclado	Difficulties in both types of reading: direct and indirect reading / Dificultades en ambos tipos de lectura: lectura directa y lectura indirecta
