### Lego In-House Field Trip for 2nd Grade

On November 1st, 2nd grade students had a unique learning opportunity. Bricks 4 Kidz, an educational Lego STEM group, came to campus and provided an In-House Field Trip. Bricks 4 Kidz, is the largest provider of STEM-based educational enrichment programs in the world. The 2nd graders learned what an orbit is and what orbits around what in our solar system. They then learned how each planetary body moves by taking on the roles of parts of our solar system.

Once 2nd grade students understood how each planetary body moved; students created motorized orbiters out of Legos. They worked in teams of two to follow detailed directions to build and then electrify their models. The students worked well together and were able to show their cooperation and problem solving skills. Some groups were able to complete their models quickly and then added some of their own design pieces to test their own orbiters. We had a fantastic morning of building and learning.













#### **3rd Grade Service Field Trip**

During the week of November 13th, the 3rd Grade classes attended a service project field trip at the Azinger Compassion Center in Palmetto. As a 3rd Grade team we wanted our students to truly experience "service in God's world" as stated in our BCS mission statement.



Each class went on a different day in order to be more useful to the Center. The field trip started with a tour of the Center and an explanation of what the Center does. Students were able to learn firsthand about the organization and understand how they were helping. Students and parents then helped unload a semi-truck full of donated goods. We worked in an assembly line filling boxes with cleaning supplies to be sent to Orlando. We also broke down boxes and helped put the filled boxes onto pallets. The students really enjoyed being able to help those in need. This is a field trip we hope to continue for years to come. We feel it is never too early to start serving others.



#### 4th Grade's Adventure at Emerson Point Preserve

Earlier this month, our students dove into nature's wonders during a memorable field trip to Emerson Point Preserve. From dipnetting in estuaries to exploring Native Floridian tools and shell mounds, the day was a hands-on lesson in Florida's rich history and biodiversity.









#### **5th Grade Balloon Races**

In 5th grade, the students start learning about the basics of physics (Newton's Laws of Motion, the Law of Conservation of Energy, etc). In order to see these laws applied in real life, they make balloon cars. They spend about two weeks learning about the process of creation. They start with an idea, learn that those ideas are not always perfect, and how they can improve on that idea. They test their final product and learn how to take accurate data, and even have a race day at the end of the unit. It was a very hands on application and the kids had a blast!




