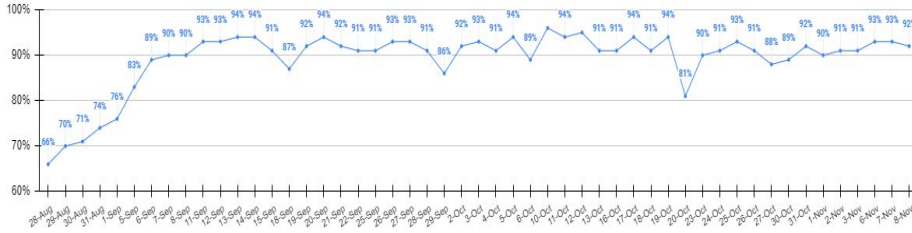

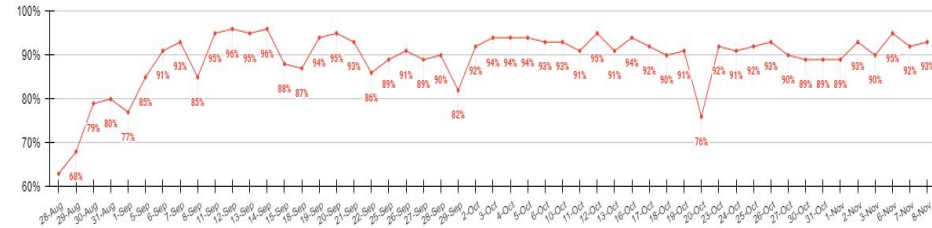

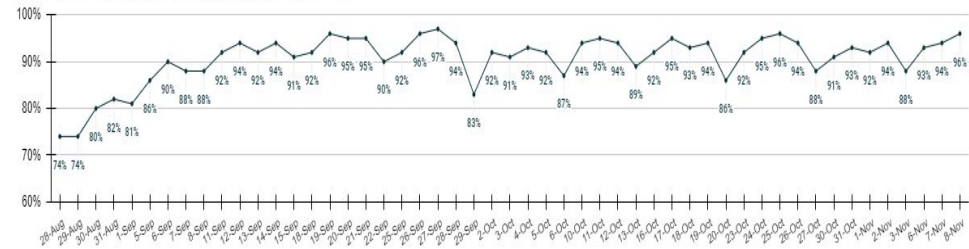
High School - Average Daily Attendance



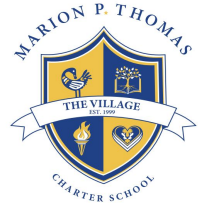
PAC ACADEMY - Average Daily Attendance



STEAM ACADEMY - Average Daily Attendance

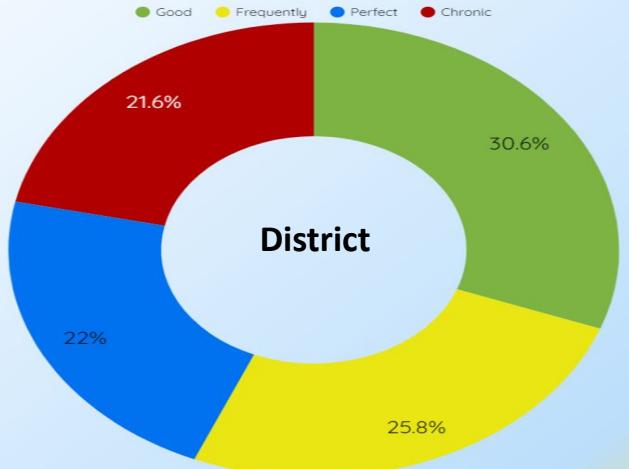
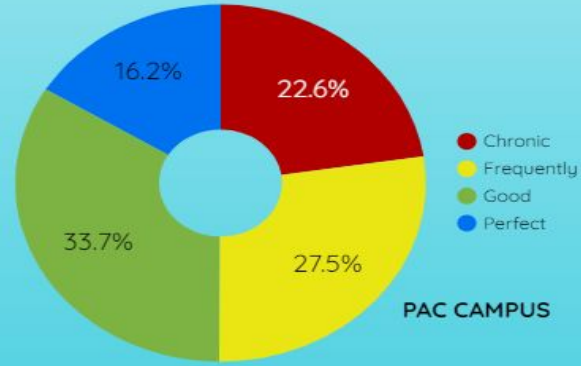
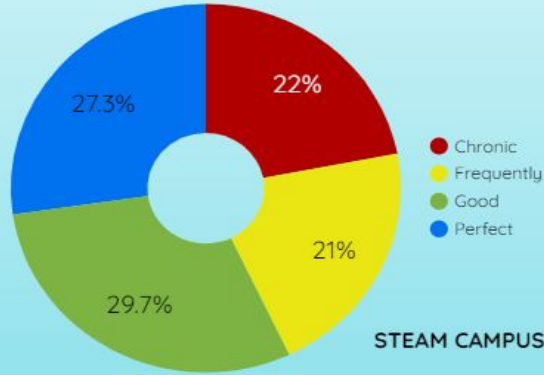
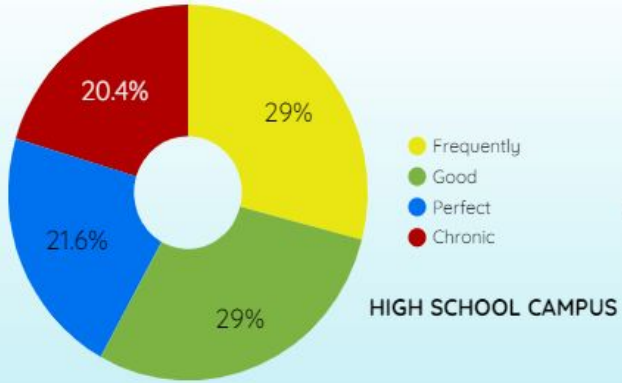

MPTCS Science Programs and Initiatives

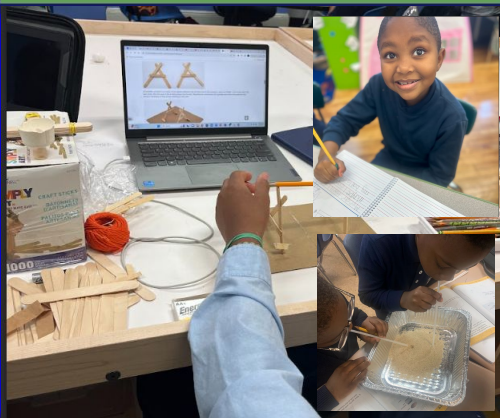
