THE WHY

Our new Strategic Plan is an overarching, guiding document that provides clear direction to Sunnyside School District staff, families, and community about where we intend to lead our schools and scholars in the near future.

THE PROCESS

The Strategic Planning Process started in February 2023, with stakeholder engagement activities and the creation of the Strategic Planning Team. The team worked together over four months to identify priorities and initiatives that outlined our beliefs in educating scholars and supporting staff and families. The plan was finalized and presented to the Sunnyside School District Board of Directors in July and unveiled to SSD staff in August.

THE FUTURE

Designed to cover a five-year time span, our District will use the Strategic Plan to design and implement projects and activities to ensure they are aligned to goals within each Priority.

Expect to see messages shared across our District's communication channels that highlight the work being done by staff and scholars, and opportunities for our schools and leaders to gather feedback from stakeholders.

KEY INITIATIVE	WHY THIS IS CRITICAL
Prepared for Kindergarten	Research shows that students who enter kindergarten ready for learning are more likely to experience long-term academic success and personal well-being. Together we will provide families with clarity of kinder readiness goals, and support them with organized resources through community outreach.
Early Literacy and Language Development	Early literacy and language development skills provide students with a strong foundation for academic success. Together we will provide aligned rigorous curriculum and instruction in grades TK-3rd grade that focuses on the science of reading.
Road Trip to Algebra	Proficiency in algebraic thinking by 10th grade is crucial for college and career readiness. Together we will emphasize the algebraic standards, foster problem-solving skills, and develop analytical thinking TK-10th grade.
Targeted Skills and Experiences at Every Grade	When standards are aligned across grade levels it creates a seamless progression of skills and knowledge. Together we will identify essential academic skills and SEL competencies by grade level to develop pacing guides to ensure consistency and clarity of what students are expected to learn.

KEY INITIATIVE	WHY THIS IS CRITICAL
Engaging Learning Experiences	Engaging learning experiences ignite students' motivation and love for learning. Together we will provide a rigorous academic program that will develop solid writing skills, inquiry based thinking, collaboration, organizational skills, and proficient reading strategies across all grades and content through AVID.
Strong PLCs to Implement CIA Framework	Strong Professional Learning Communities foster collaboration, continuous professional growth, and data-informed decision-making, and are student-centered. Together we will identify essential standards at all grades and contents, implement common assessments, and analyze data to provide timely tiered systems of support interventions and enrichments for students.
Tiered Systems of Support: Academics	Tiered systems provide personalized instruction, early intervention, and prevention, while adopting a data-driven, collaborative culture. Together we will clearly identify and provide Tier I instruction with an emphasis on inclusionary practices for special populations to provide an equitable education for all.
Emerging Practices and Technologies	Students develop digital citizenship and sound technological skills which foster learning and innovation, and prepare them to adapt to an ever-evolving society. Together we will provide professional development for staff and lessons for students on emerging practices to develop digital literacy to equip students with essential competencies for success in the modern world.

KEY INITIATIVE	WHY THIS IS CRITICAL
Tiered Systems of Support: Wellness	By implementing tiered systems of support for wellness, students will have the necessary resources, interventions, and strategies to thrive emotionally, socially, and mentally. Together we will support all students through Tier I wellness instruction, and prevention protocols, and will identify response systems for our most vulnerable students.
Connect, Build, and Envision Programming	Creating strong connections among students, staff, and the school community fosters positive relationships, a sense of belonging and supports students to reach their full potential. Together we will intentionally align and monitor our practices to ensure all students have an adult they trust, are connected to healthy activities, and have opportunities to envision their future.
Community-Wide Awareness Campaign	Supporting the diverse needs and identities of all students will create an inclusive environment where every individual feels valued, respected, and empowered. Together we will provide ongoing awareness and professional development on equitable and inclusive practices that emphasize the destigmatization of mental health and the removal of barriers to promote inclusivity.
Deeper Integration of SEL and Cultural Competency	Academic success alone is not enough for our students to thrive; by supporting the education of administrators and teachers to integrate Tier 1 Social Emotional Instruction and develop cultural competency, we are ensuring our students will become career, college, and life ready.

KEY INITIATIVE	WHY THIS IS CRITICAL
Aligned High School and Beyond Planning	Centering post-secondary planning on a student's interest, goals and strengths is essential to increasing their chances of a successful transition into post-secondary adulthood. Together we will align programs that connect students' elementary, middle and high school experiences with their post-secondary plans and aspirations.
Rigorous and Advanced Pathways	Challenging coursework allows students to expand their knowledge, deepen their understanding, and develop critical thinking skills. Together we will challenge our students to solve complex problems and explore new ideas, fostering intellectual growth and preparing them for higher education and the workforce.
Expanded Career Exploration	By connecting current coursework, activities, and skill building with their future, students are able to make informed decisions about their future paths and pursue meaningful careers. Together we will increase our partnerships with local businesses and post-secondary institutions to expand opportunities to learn first hand about different careers and industries.
Post-Secondary Student Support	Navigating the transition out of high school and into higher education, advanced technical training, or directly into the workforce is challenging and complex. Together we will provide support and resources for all Sunnyside graduates to enroll in college, search for career opportunities, and apply for roles.
