I would like to help my child make choices about what they are reading... What are my options?

You can ask your child's teacher to share books being assigned for class. If you have concerns, you can ask that your child have an alternate assignment.

You can always ask to meet with your child's principal, teacher or librarian to discuss your options.

You can give the campus librarian a list of books you do not want your child to be able to check out.



If you believe the book is inappropriate for all students (not just your child) you can formally challenge the book.
