Fall Festival at Northeast Primary

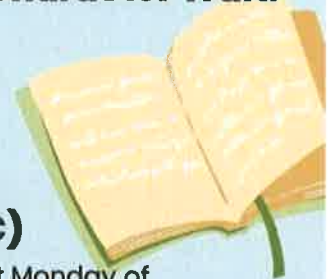

Join us virtually on the first Monday of each month at 6:00 pm. We welcome our families support in providing our students with new experiences and opportunities!





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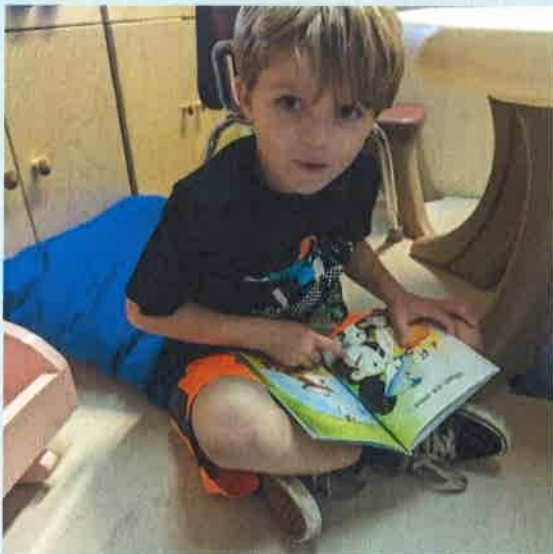
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Kindhearted Kindergarten
