J.O.I CLUB

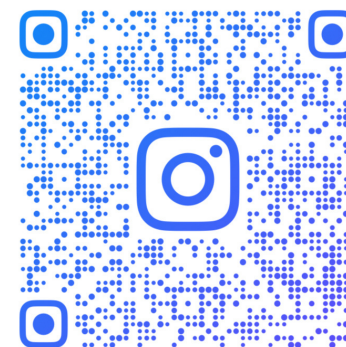
