SOA is located at Bruton High School.


Transportation from York County high schools is provided.

- No audition required. Non-SOA students may enroll if there's space.



How do I get there?

SOA is located at Bruton High School. Transportation is provided from YCSD high schools, but students must have their own transportation to their home high school.

Can SOA students participate in other activities?

Yes, we have many students who are in ROTC, band, and athletics. Students can also participate in *both* IB and SOA during freshman and sophomore years.

Do students have to reapply every year?

No, once accepted into a program and maintin academic & behaviors requirements, you may remain in the program.

Can I apply for more than one discipline?

Yes, students may (and should) apply to every discipline in which they are interested. Students may enroll in as many SOA disciplines as they can fit in their schedule.

Can I apply if I'm already in high school?

Yes, students can apply at any high school grade level, even upcoming seniors.

*For current 8th graders to be included in the February 2024 auditions, applications must be received by **January 19, 2024**. Transportation for auditioning 8th graders will be provided from home schools to the School of the Arts for the February auditions only. Other applications will be processed as they are received and scheduled to audition at a later date.
