(Seniors) SUU T-Bird Promise Scholarship: The aim of this scholarship is to eliminate financial barriers for underserved student populations to promote access to an equitable education. This need based scholarship can be awarded up to full tuition for the academic year. Students who are not Pell grant eligible can still be considered for the scholarship. This scholarship is renewable for 8 academic semesters if you maintain a 2.0 GPA, complete 70% of your courses, and are a full-time student.
