
Download the Securly Home App

View your child's real-time activity feed, right from the palm of your hand.




With the **Securly Home app**, you'll have a real-time view of your child's activity on their school device. You'll also get weekly emails from Securly with a snapshot report of that week's activity.

Open the app and tap the **Login button**


Enter the email address you have registered with your child's school and tap the **"Get instant access"** button.


