PPS 2nd graders are creating their habitat projects to support their science SOLs. This is a wonderful hands-on project that continues year after year.

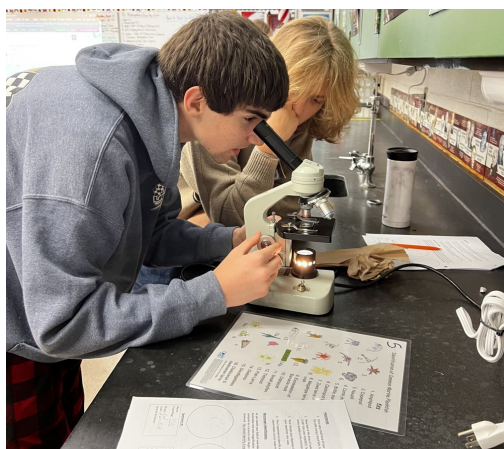
Officer Pete has been providing wonderful lessons to our students through the DARE program about safety in school, at home, and in the community.
