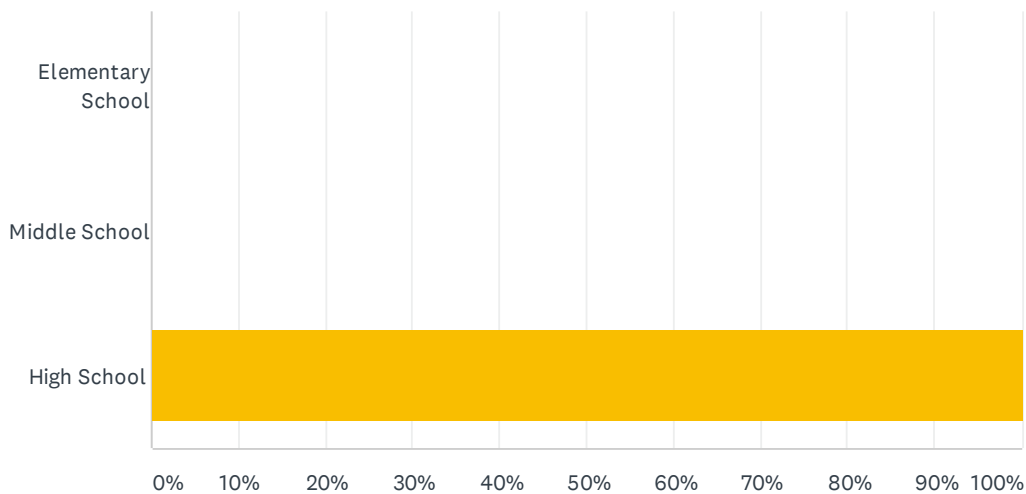

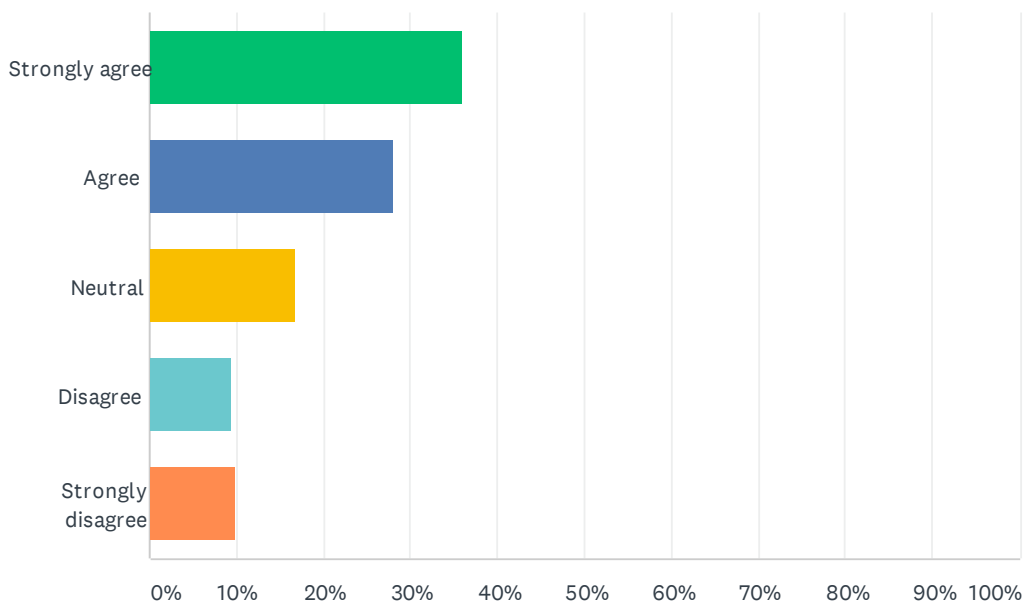

Q2 I believe in-person school should resume in September and face coverings should be worn by STAFF and STUDENTS when social distancing is not possible and my child will be in attendance.

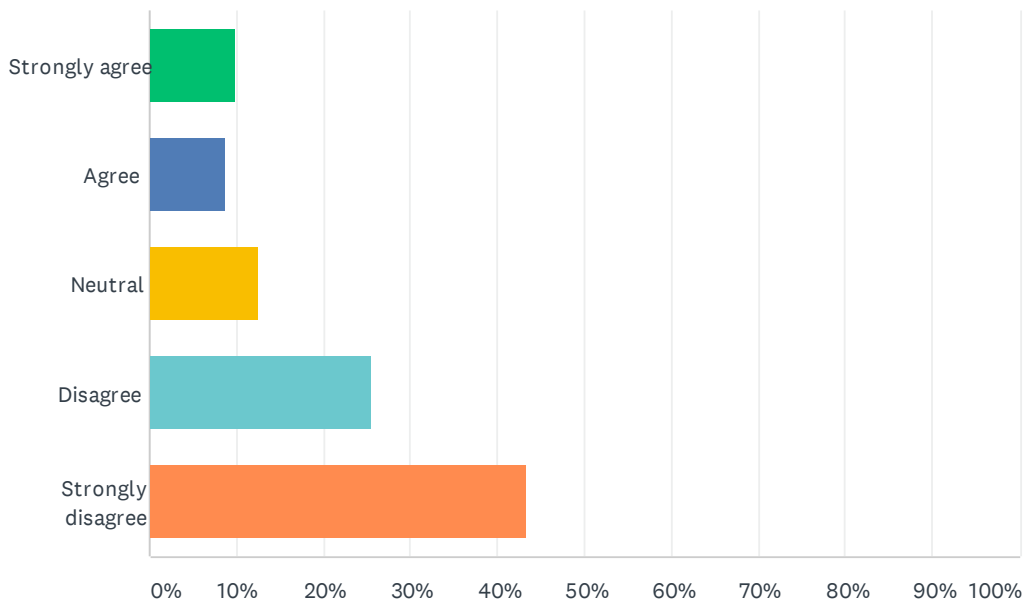

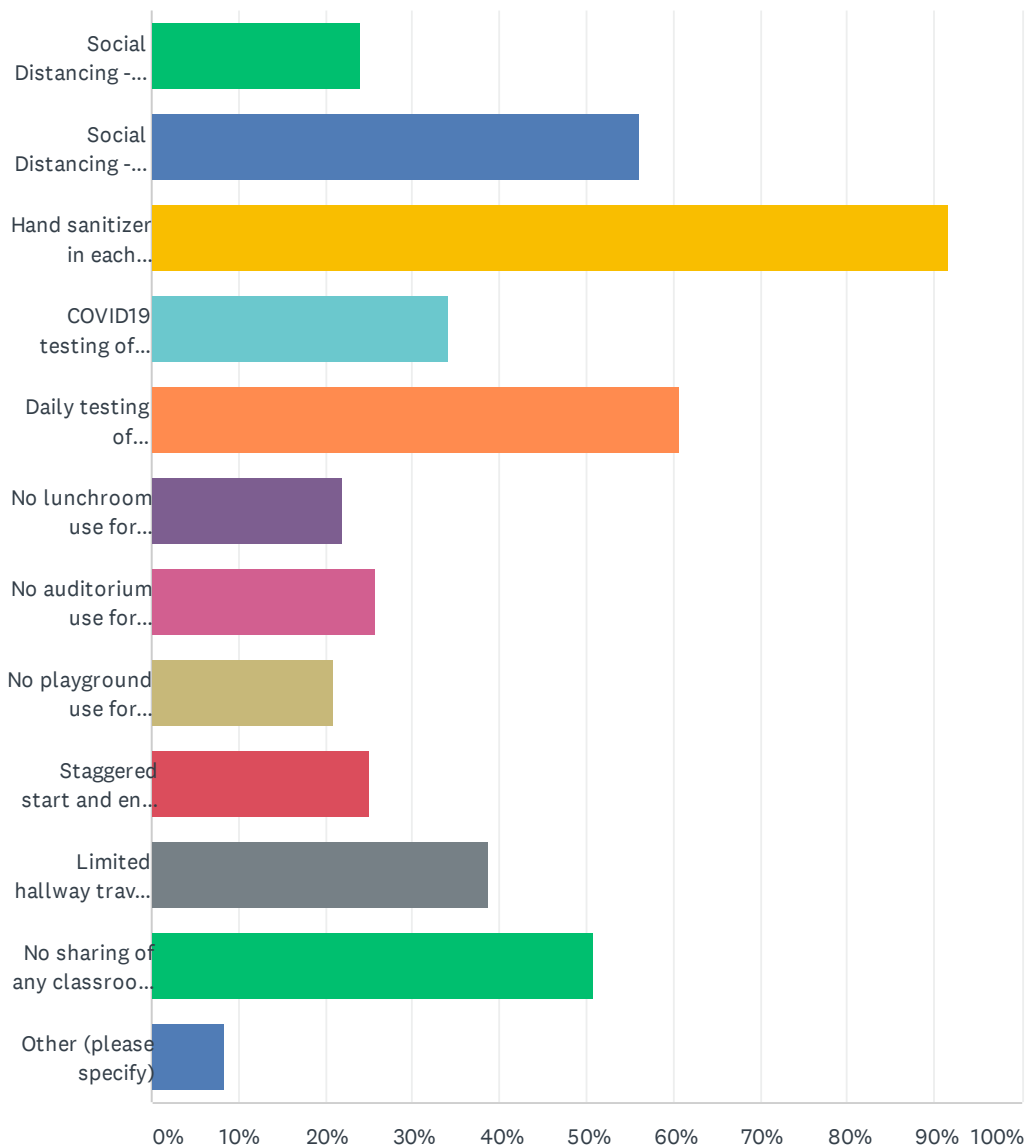

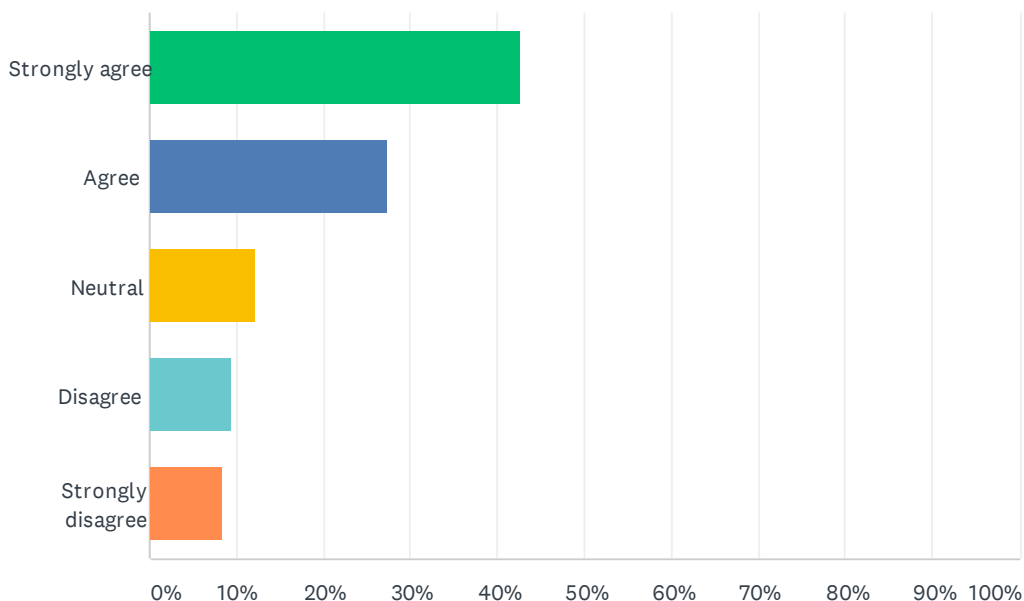

Q5 I believe in-person school SHOULD resume as normal, in September, with some new procedures to reduce the spread of illness.

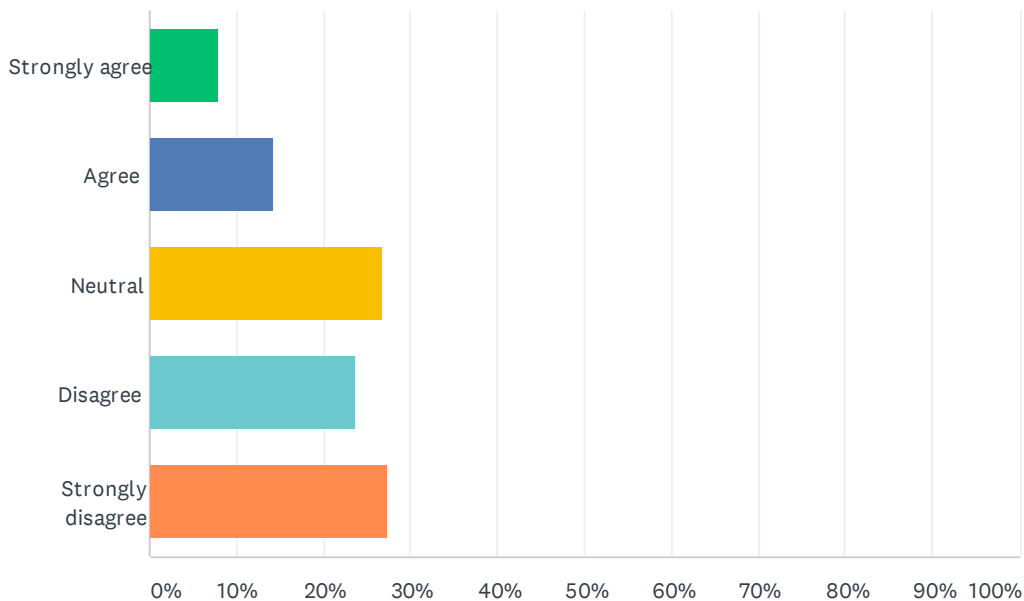

Q6 I believe in-person school should resume in September, with HALF of the students ATTENDING SCHOOL on any given day and the other HALF of the students virtually learning from HOME.

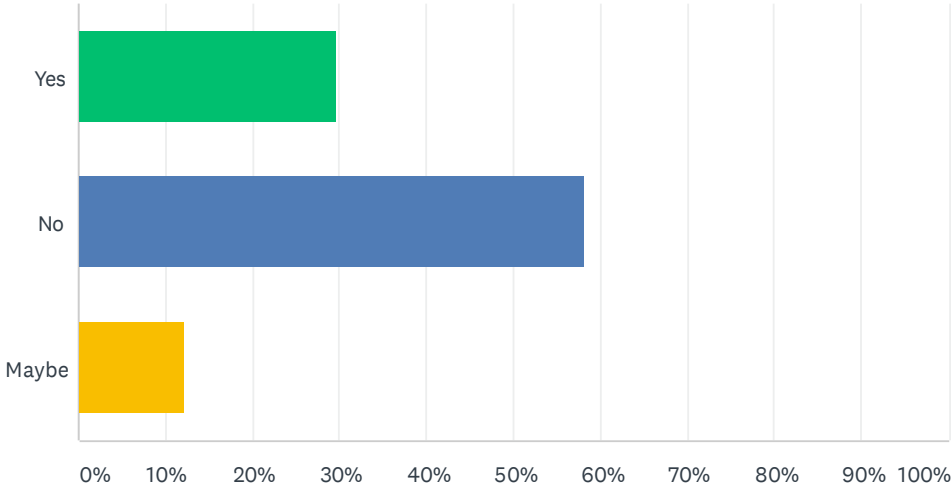

Q7 Will your student require school transportation?

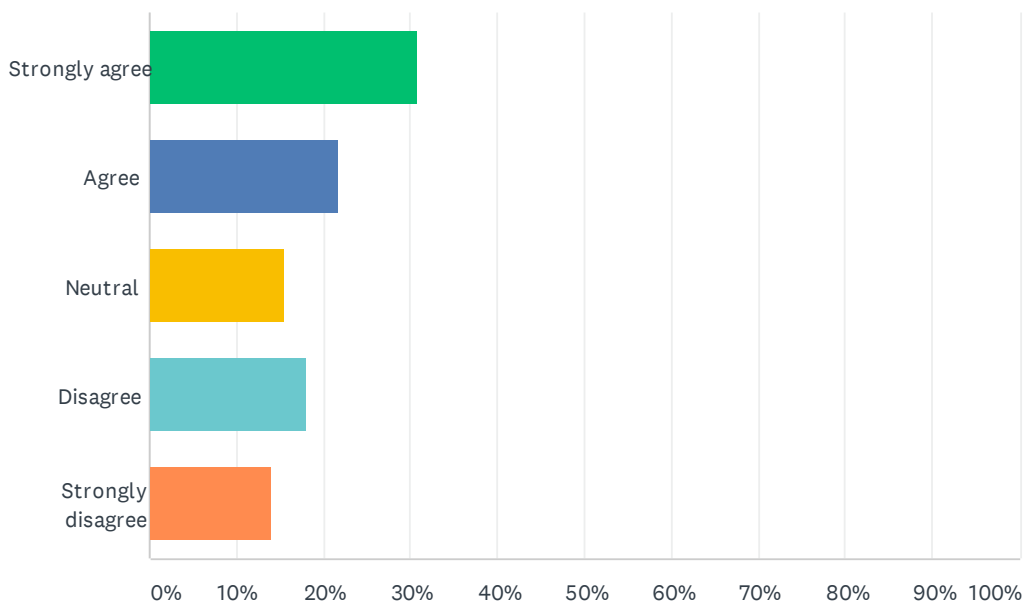

Q8 I am comfortable with my student(s) being transported everyday to and from school on a deep cleaned/sanitized school bus with regular volumes of student passengers.

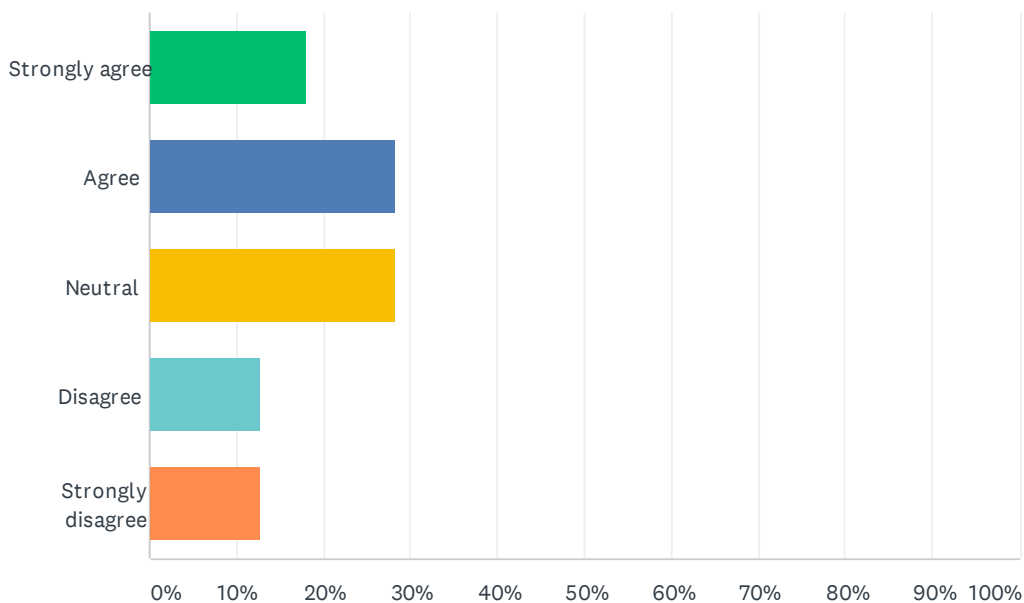

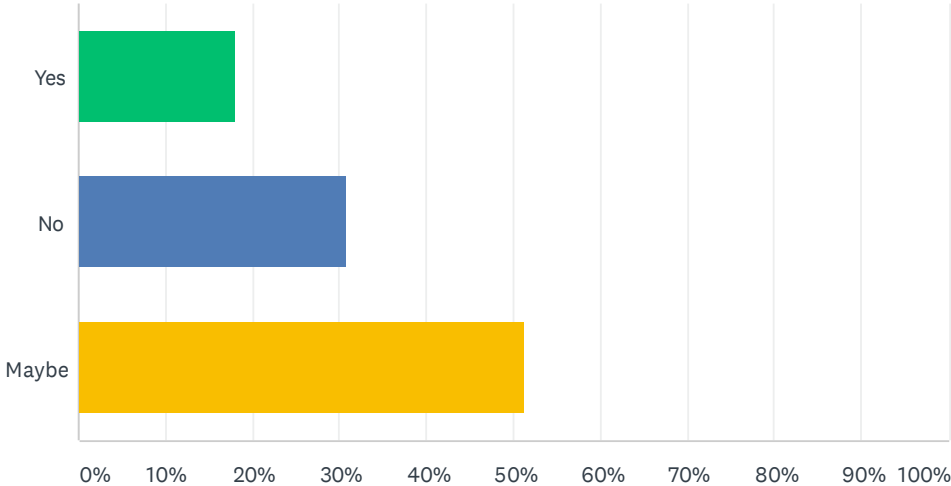

Q10 I would transport my student(s) to help reduce the number of students on a bus at any given time.

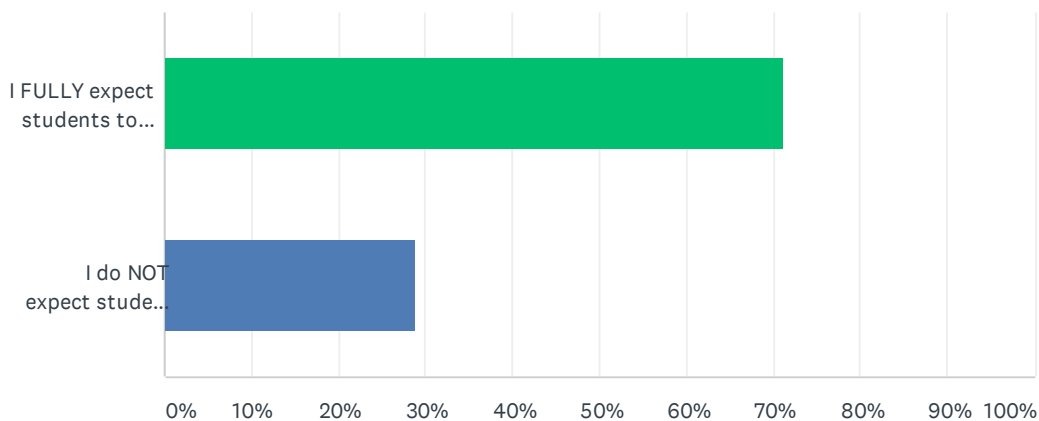

Q11 What is your expectation regarding participation of students in athletics, performing arts, and extra-curricular activities if students return to school in September?

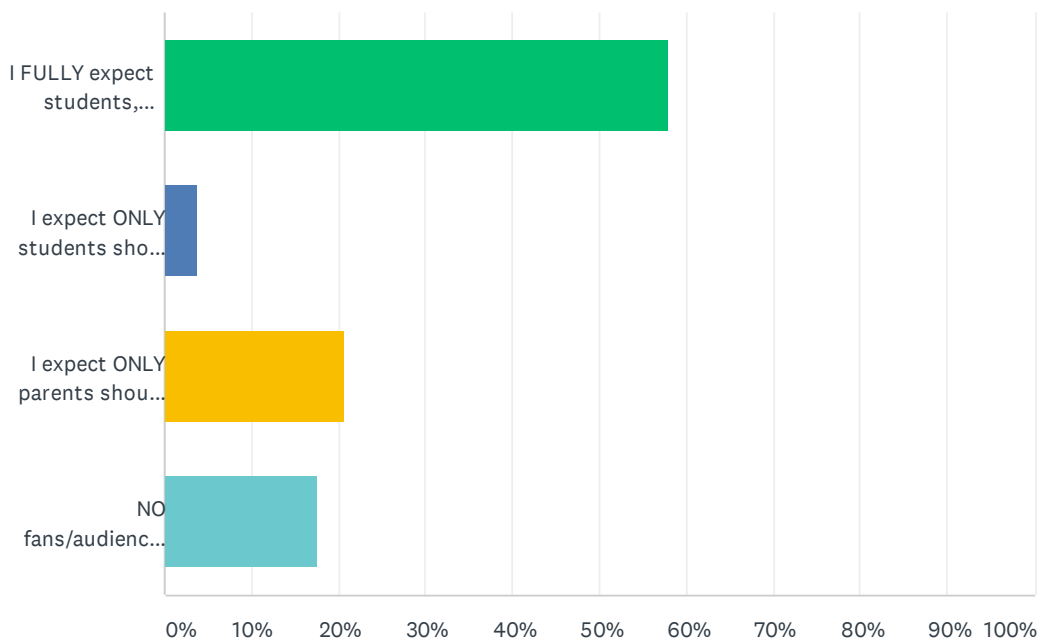
