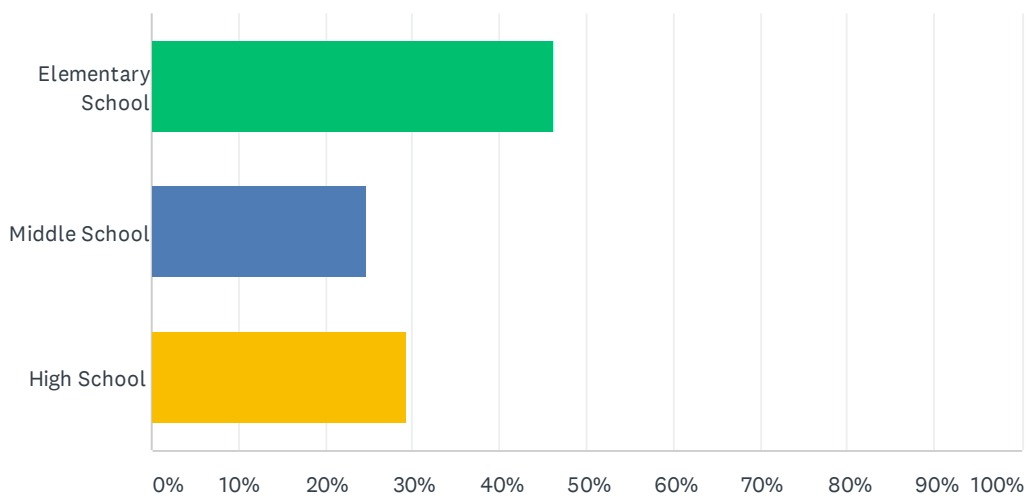

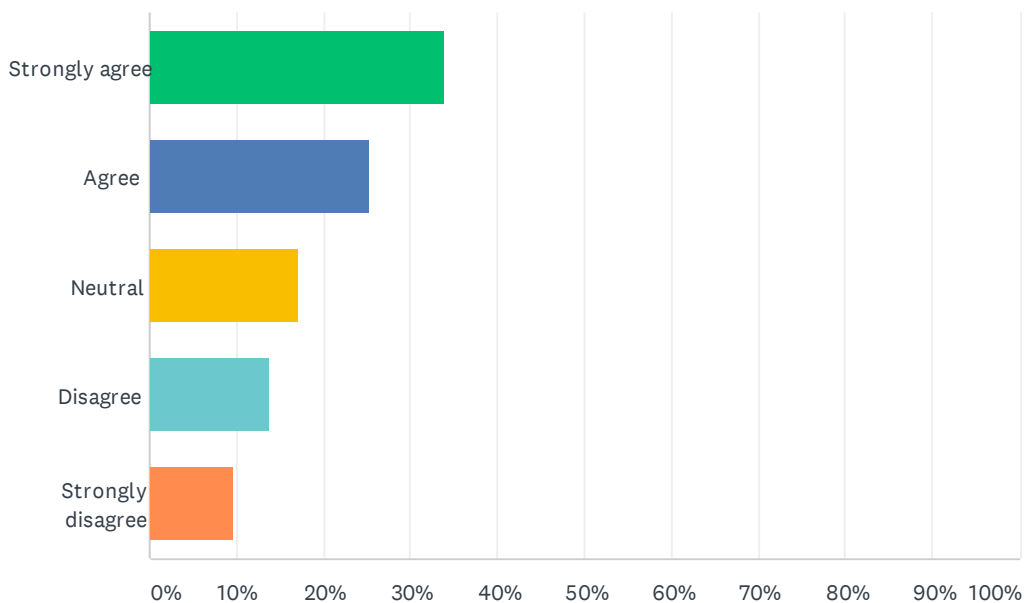

## Q2 I believe in-person school should resume in September and face coverings should be worn by STAFF and STUDENTS when social distancing is not possible and my child will be in attendance.

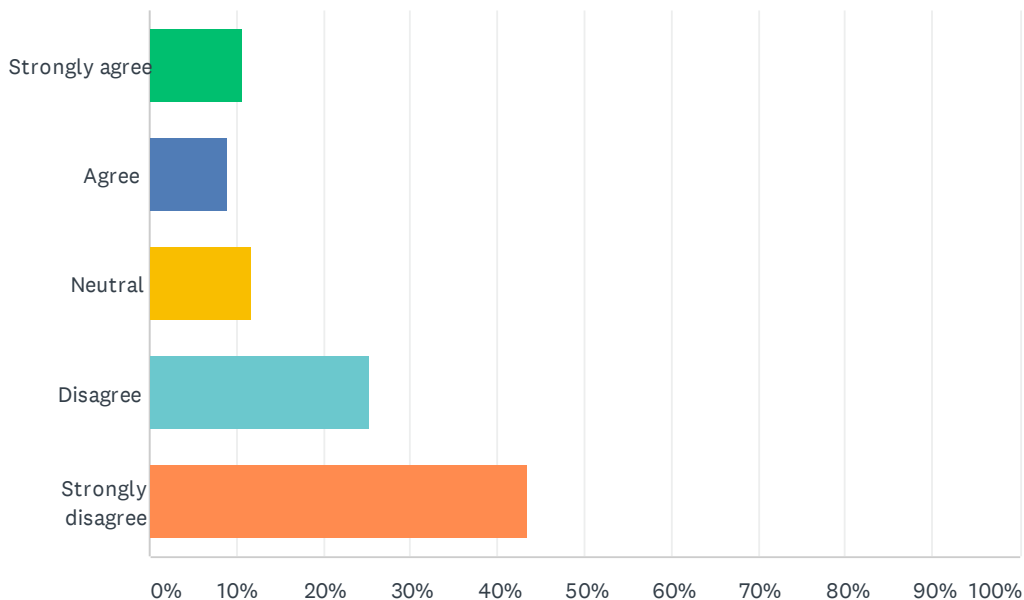

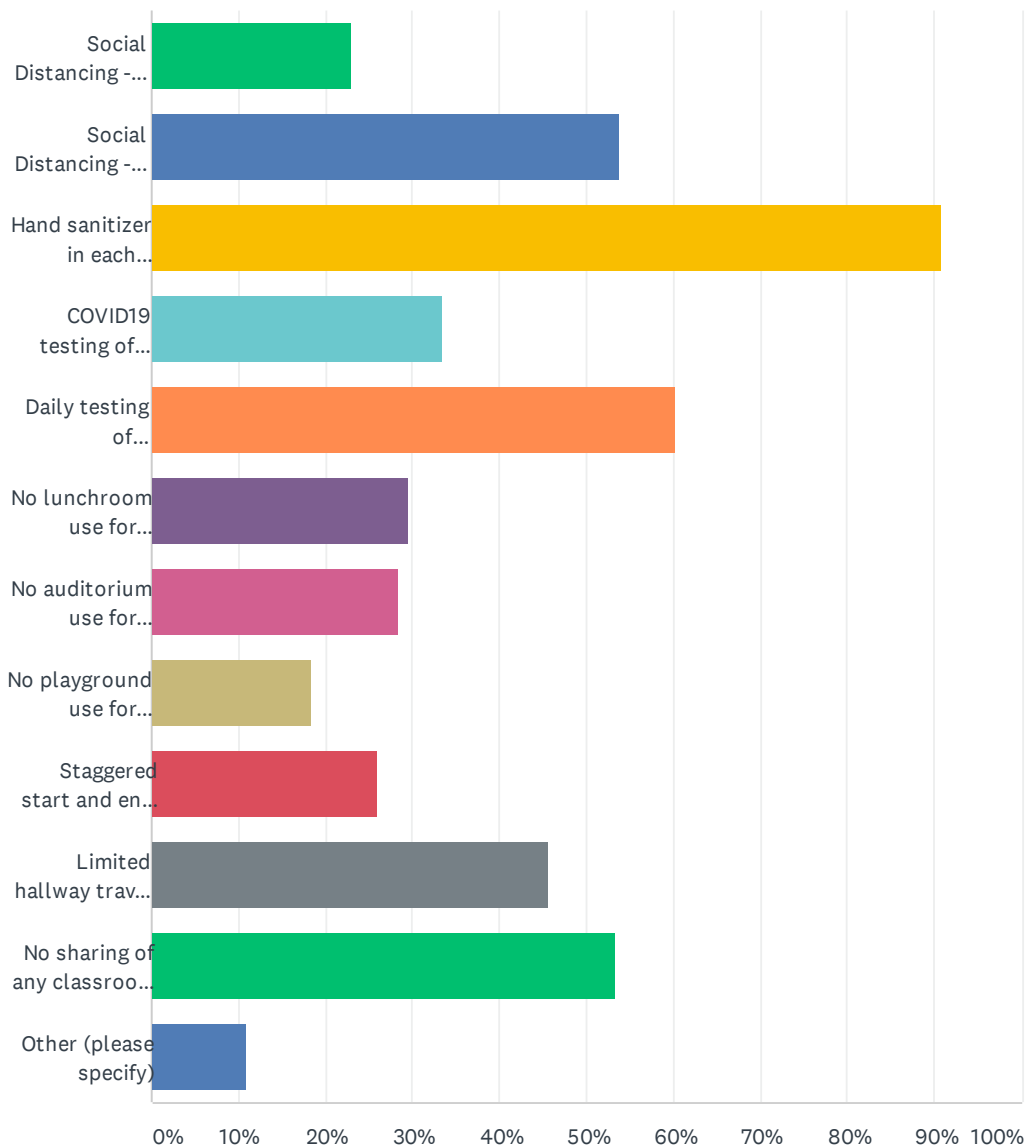

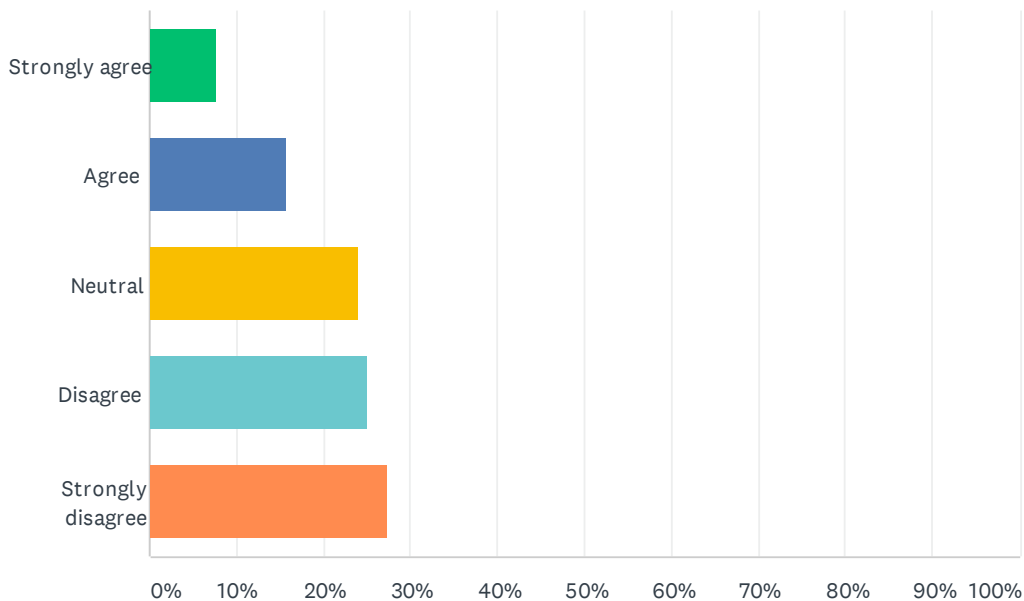

Q6 I believe in-person school should resume in September, with HALF of the students ATTENDING SCHOOL on any given day and the other HALF of the students virtually learning from HOME.

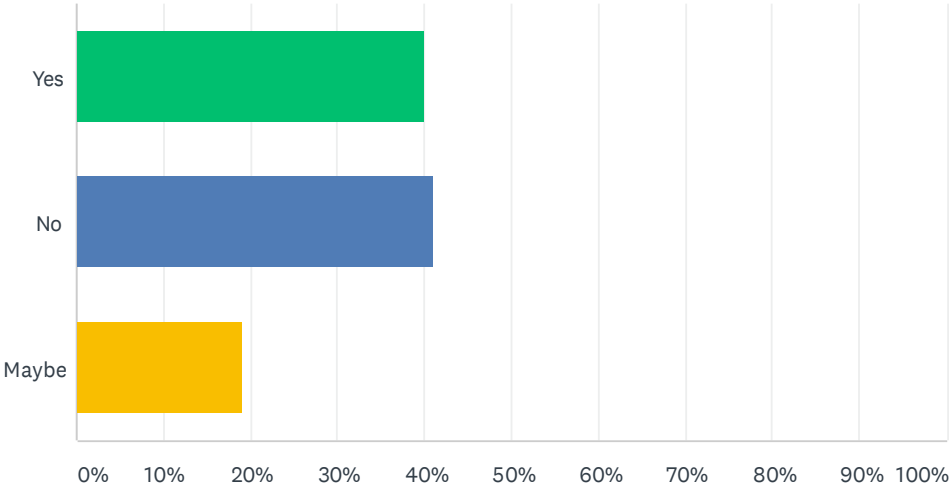

### Q7 Will your student require school transportation?

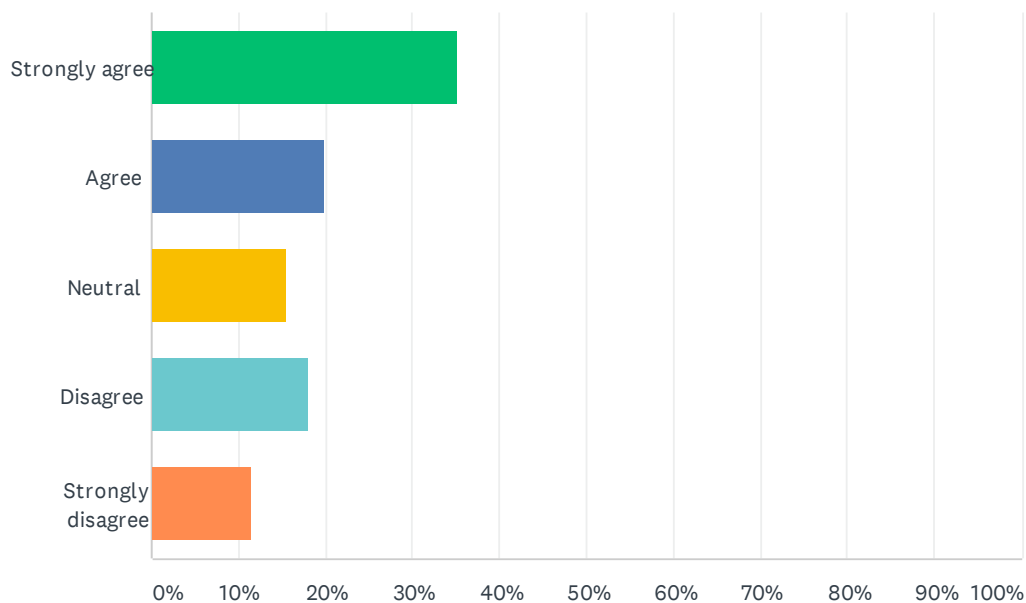

### Q8 I am comfortable with my student(s) being transported everyday to and from school on a deep cleaned/sanitized school bus with regular volumes of student passengers.

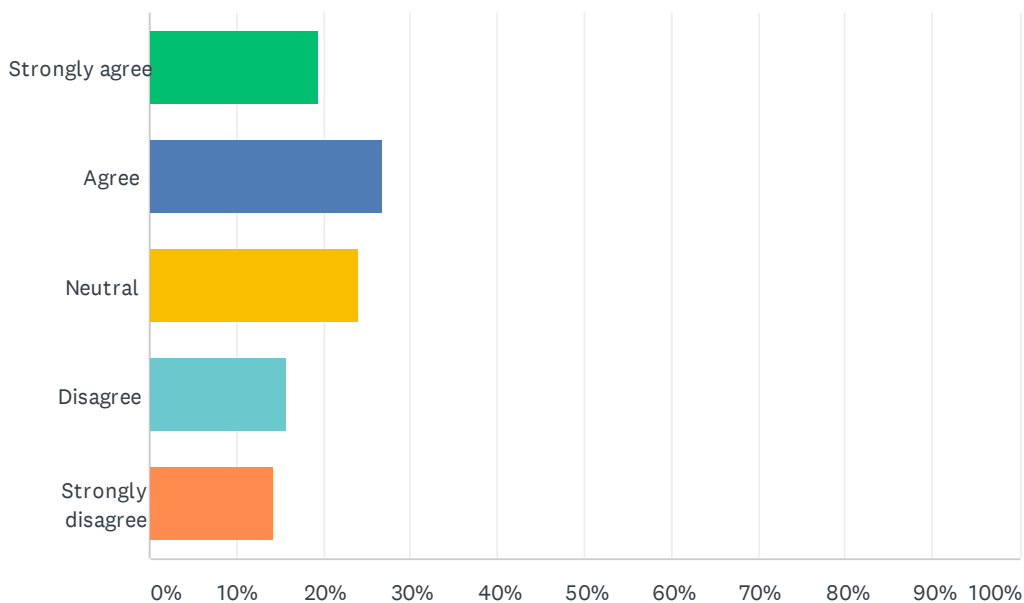

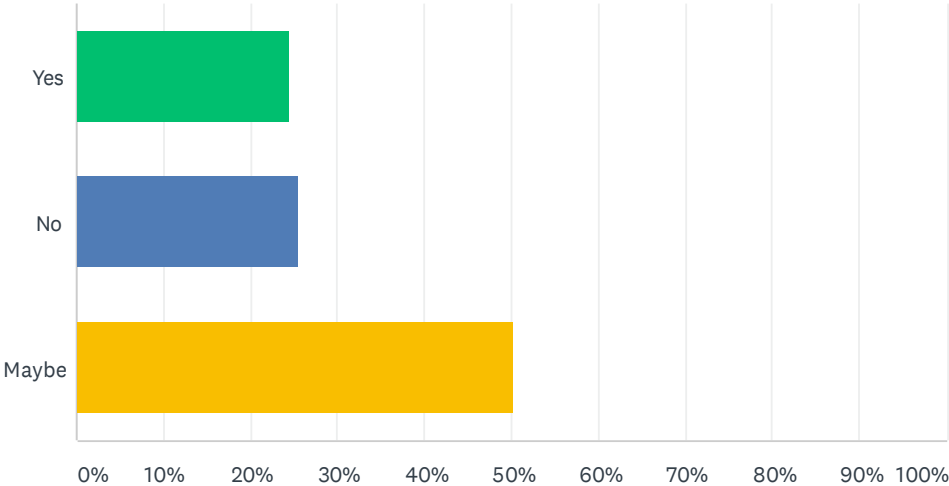

### Q10 I would transport my student(s) to help reduce the number of students on a bus at any given time.

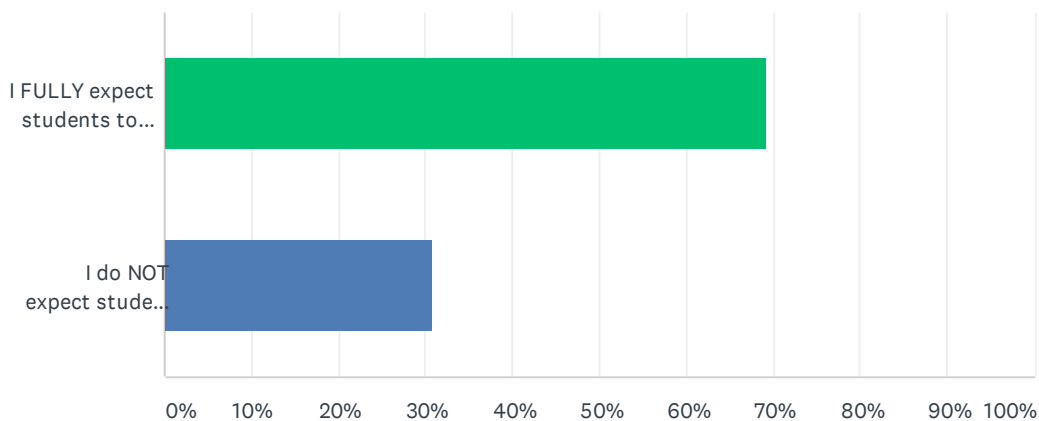

## Q11 What is your expectation regarding participation of students in athletics, performing arts, and extra-curricular activities if students return to school in September?

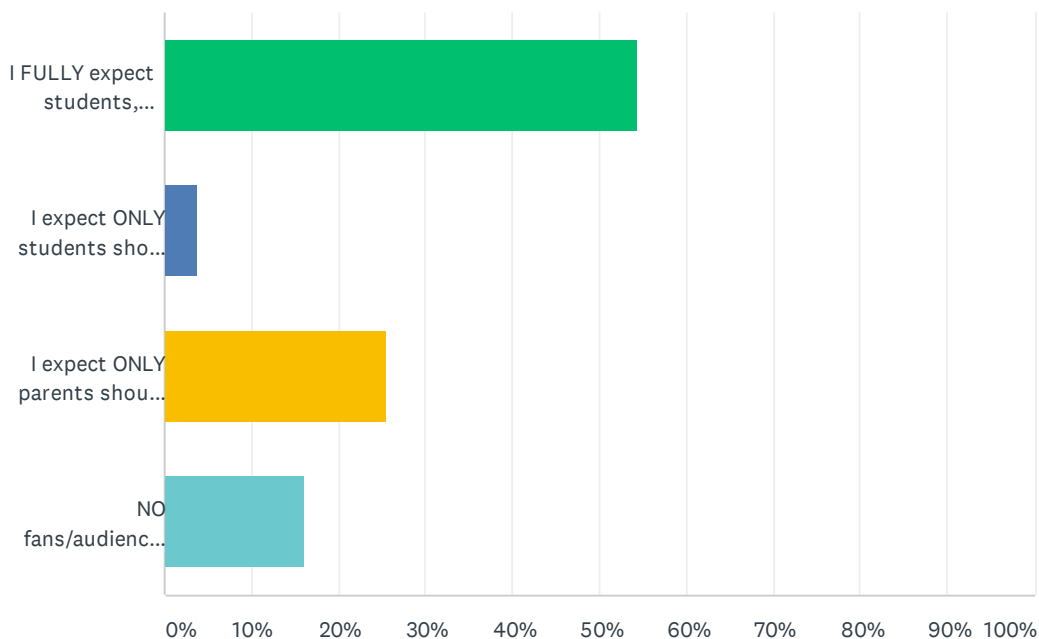
