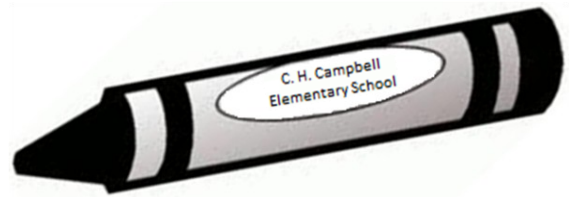

Smile Station - Mobile Dental Clinic

Smile Station Dental Van forms will be sent home on January 5th, 2024. If you would like your child to be seen in the mobile dental van, please read the forms to determine if your child qualifies. If they qualify, please complete and return the forms by January 12th, 2024. The van will be here January 17th, 2024.

Cough Drop usage in school

Coughs are a normal part of a cold. At times the cough can become bothersome and may warrant a drink of water. Cough drops are considered an over-the-counter medication and require the completion of the Medication Policy Form with a physician's signature. Cough drops will then be kept in the clinic. When your child is coughing to the extent he or she would be disruptive to classroom activities, your child should stay home.

Chap Stick usage in school

Chap Stick should be applied at home before school by the parent/guardian. It can also be applied by the parent/guardian before bed to prevent chapping. For very red or bleeding chapped lips, the student may come down to the clinic for petrolatum to be applied. Chap stick should not be brought to school.

School Closings and 2 Hour Delays

The district will be utilizing the School Messenger system to inform parents of school closings and 2 hour delays this year. Please remember that a two hour delay means that buses will be arriving at the bus stops two hours later than normal. There is no recess on 2 hour delay days.
