

# November Book Review: Room 13 by Robert Swindells, recommended for Year 5

This book starts with the main character Fliss, having a creepy dream. The next day she is supposed to go on her school trip to Whitby, the Yorkshire seaside town, also known as the place where Dracula's ship crashed ashore in the famous novel of the same name by Bram Stoker.
