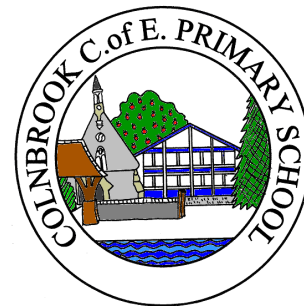

November Book Review:

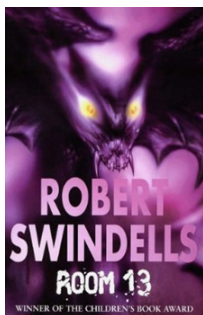
Room 13 by Robert Swindells, recommended for Year 5

This book starts with the main character Fliss, having a creepy
dream. The next day she is supposed to go on her school trip
to Whitby, the Yorkshire seaside town, also known as the
place where Dracula's ship crashed ashore in the famous
novel of the same name by Bram Stoker.

Fliss and her friends are caught in the middle of a little horror
tale happening right under the noses of the adults. The
characters are great and the author captures the atmosphere
well on a school trip.

The story builds as the tension creeps up, each chapter leaving
you hanging, wanting to know what happens next.

It may not be the best book to read at bedtime but it is great if you enjoy scary
